The work was awarded to Rams Contracting Ltd. (Rams), the lowest responsive and responsible bidder. The original award amount was \$40,313.00. This amount fell under the threshold of \$250,000.00 above which approval by the HACM Board of Commissioners is required; therefore, said award was not presented to the board for approval at that time. During the course of construction, additional topsoil spreading work beyond the original scope was required, resulting in a cumulative change order amount of \$299,000.00 not-to-exceed. This amount includes previous increases for approved work items as well as a non-to-exceed increase for the remaining work items that are being calculated and finalized. Most of the additional work items were needed for relocation of stored or excess soil that had to be relocated to make way for site development and building construction. Some work items were considered an emergency to address safety concerns at various residences and within the neighborhood. Since Rams was already contracted for topsoil spreading work and mobilized on site, staff solicited Rams to take on the additional work, which Rams was willing to do on a time & materials basis. For some of the larger work items, staff solicited firm pricing in advance, include pricing from other contractors to ensure that Ram's pricing was competitive. The Modernization & Development Services Section recommends executing the cumulative change order as described above. The new purchase order amount of \$339,313.00 not-to-exceed now exceeds the aforementioned \$250,000.00 threshold: therefore, approval by the HACM Board of Commissioners is required.
