The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 9/12/2017 at 1:45 PM, in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing. Please review the information below and if you have further questions regarding this process, please contact the License Division at (414) 286-2238.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

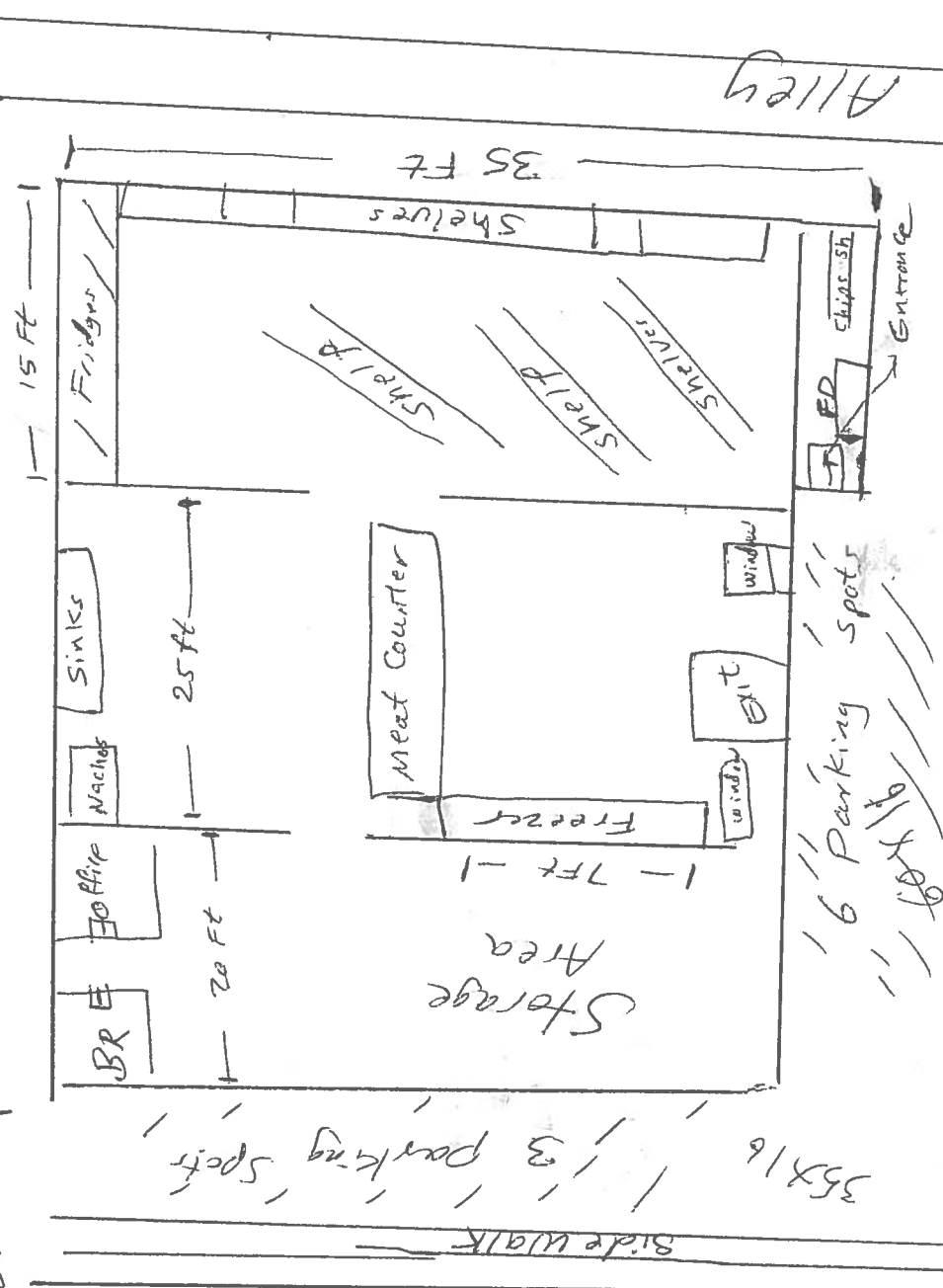

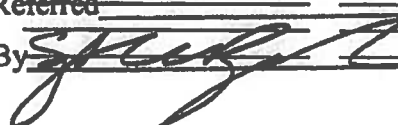

This report was written by P.O. Bowie BUCHNER, assigned to district seven, early power. On Friday July 14, 2017 I met with Edward A BROWN Jr regarding his application for a new liquor license for 5700 W Fond Du Lac Av (court mvp)

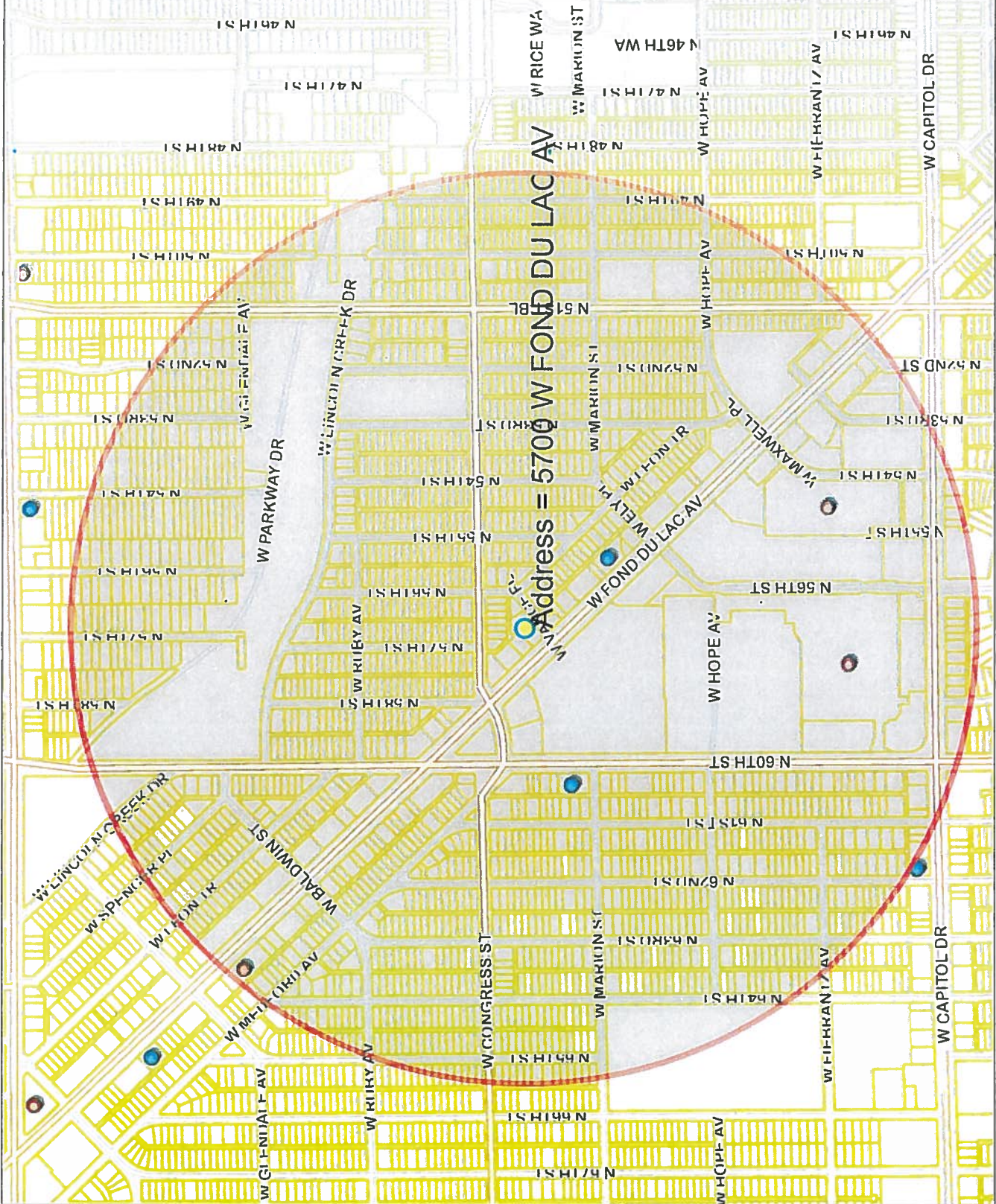
Upon arrival I observed that the exterior of the location was neat and orderly. I could not see into the business as there were curtains closed on the inside of the location. I did not observe any exterior camera. I did observe a parking lot in the rear of the location (east side of the building). I did observe two large street lamp style lights in the parking lot, however due to the daylight hour I was unable to observe if the lighting was adequate or not.

Inside the location was neat and orderly. There was some dust and tools on the bar area. However, it was obvious that work was being done to the interior at the time of my visit. I did observe that when the curtains on the windows were opened I could see to the outside of the building. BROWN stated he put the curtains up while renovations were being done so that no one could see that tools were left inside the building.

When asked about security cameras BROWN stated that he was going to install security cameras before the bar opened. BROWN stated he had purchased some camera already, but was unsure how many he would place inside and how many outside. BROWN did state that he would have a camera pointed at the entrance and at least one camera covering all side or the building's exterior. Also, BROWN would have at least one camera watching the parking lot. BROWN stated that the cameras he used recorded in color and digital HD. BROWN stated that the cameras would retain the video for 14 days, but that he planned to purchase a hard drive to store the video also. BROWN stated that the hard drive would hold video until it was full and then it would loop. BROWN also stated that there would be at least one employee on the premise at all times that would be able to retrieve video.

This report is written by P.O. Matthew ZANIEWSKI assigned to District 7, Late Shift.

On Saturday January 21, 2017 while on squad 7340 in full duty uniform and operating a marked squad car I was dispatched to St. Joseph's Hospital 5000 W Chambers St in the city and county of Milwaukee for a Battery Cutting.

Upon arrival I observed a b/m with a deep laceration on his forehead being worked on by hospital staff. The male was able to state that his name was BROOKS, Cantrell D b/m 11/18/1985. BROOKS stated that he believed he was setup and got beat up.

BROOKS stated that he went to Golddiggers Strip Club 4750 W Hopkins in the city and county of Milwaukee. BROOKS stated that while he was there he met a female stripper that BROOKS described as b/f 20-25 years old 5'8 slim build, long black hair possible extensions, tattoo's covering her arm wearing a gray Pink brand jogging suit.

BROOKS stated that at some point the stripper asked him to leave with her. BROOKS stated that he agreed, and left the strip club with the stripper. BROOKS stated that they then walked a block or two away from the strip club. BROOKS stated that he is very unfamiliar with the area and had no idea where they walked to. BROOKS stated that all of the sudden he was hit in the back of the head by a male. BROOKS stated that he turned around then got hit in the face with a sharp object he believed to be a knife. BROOKS stated that he began to fight for his life, and stated he had never felt that much pain before. BROOKS stated that he saw a lot of blood and continued to fight for his life. BROOKS stated that he then blacked out and doesn't remember what happened. BROOKS stated that he feared for his safety and that he did not give consent. BROOKS stated that he believed he was setup by the stripper. BROOKS was unaware if anything was taken.

When I P.O. ZANIEWSKI was speaking with brooks he appeared to be very disorientated and intoxicated. BROOKS was unable to provide me with a telephone number or an address for himself other then he lived somewhere near N 57th St and W North Ave. While speaking with BROOKS the hospital staff gave BROOKS a strong pain medication. The hospital staff stated that BROOKS had a laceration that was 9cm. The hospital staff gave BROOKS 4 internal stitches and 13 external stitches. BROOKS also had a small cut on his left forearm which he stated happened during the incident.
