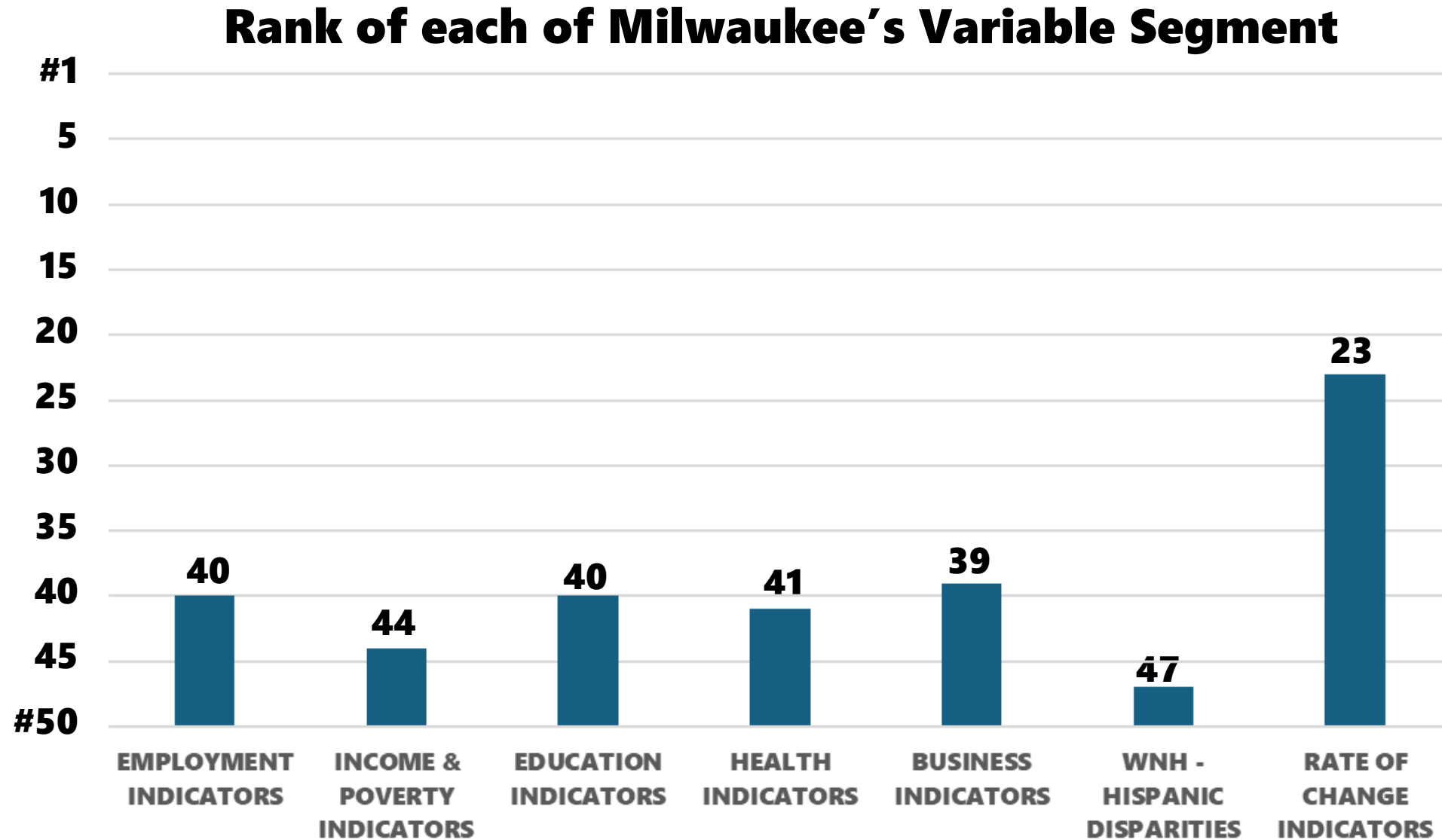

TOP TAKEAWAYS

1. Across three editions, Milwaukee remains in a tight range near the bottom 10 of nation's 50 largest metros.
2. Even though many outcomes are incrementally improving, ranking continues to drop, meaning we are not improving faster than other metros.
3. Double-digit increases in ranking are possible as demonstrated by other metros which we can continue to learn from.
4. There are important positive trends that with further investment and intentionality, we can reach a much different norm and raise regional prosperity.
