Dear Council Members:

Returned herewith is a document filed by Attorney Laurie Eggert for attorney's fees for representing Police Officer Sebastian Raclaw. The claim is in the amount of \$916.00, including \$3.00 in disbursements, for 8.30 hours of service billed at the rate of \$110.00 per hour. We ask that this matter be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation.

We have reviewed this claim and advise that in our opinion, the time spent was reasonable. Legal representation was occasioned by a criminal investigation. No criminal charges were brought against the Police Officer on whose behalf this claim was filed.

As we have advised you under similar circumstances in the past, the Common Council has discretion to reject this claim or to pay it in whole or in part. Sec. 895.35, Stats., *Bablitch and Bablitch v. Lincoln County*, 82 Wis. 2d 574 (1978).


Dear Mr. Leonhardt:



Dear Chief Jones:

As you know, I have charged Terrence Gilbert with Misconduct in Public Office and Fourth Degree Sexual Assault for an incident in which he allegedly fondled a female arrestee's breasts and told her that he would not issue a ticket for possession of marijuana if she would do a lap dance at a private party for him.

Gilbert's partner was Sebastian Raclaw. My review of this case leads me to the conclusion that Raclaw was not present when the alleged sexual assault occurred, and that he did not directly participate in the conversation regarding the lap dance. I have therefore concluded that criminal charges are not sustainable against him for those matters.
