Public Meeting To Include Discussion On Ordinance That Would Require Businesses To “Air Out The Dirty Laundry” On Slavery Profits, Participation

Ald. Mike McGee, Jr. will host a public town hall meeting tonight to discuss his proposed ordinance calling for companies and contractors who conduct business with the City of Milwaukee to fully disclose any participation in or profits derived from slavery.

Highlights of meeting will include:

- A panel discussion on an ordinance requiring businesses to expose past involvement with slavery and payment of reparations
- Possible economic sanctions for JP Morgan/Chase Banks
- An update on the federal lawsuit filed against the City of Milwaukee, Police Chief Nannette Hegerty, the Milwaukee Police Department and Milwaukee Police Association
- Promotion of the Respect Kampain’s Street Code of Conduct
