There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. This report is written by Police Officer Carlos Felix, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 03/18/16, applicant was cited for Building Code Violations at 2424 N Fratney Street.

2. On 06/26/16, Milwaukee police were dispatched to a 4<sup>th</sup> Degree Sexual Assault complaint at District #6 front desk. Investigation found the incident took place between 06/18/16 11:00 pm and 06/19/16 5:00 am at the Milwaukee Airport Inn at 1716 W Layton Avenue. The victim, who is an employee of the motel, stated a co-worker touched her body approximately 10 times during her shift at the front desk while she worked. The victim stated 5 out of 10 times the suspect intentionally and without consent, touched her vagina on the outside of her clothes. The owner of the motel, Prabhu Kasthurirangaian, cooperated with the investigation and made a copy of the security footage of the listed dates and information regarding the suspect. The case was no processed at the DA's office due to lack of evidence.
3. On 10/18/16 at 9:02 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 1716 W Layton Avenue for an armed robbery complaint. Officers spoke with an employee of the motel who stated an unknown male subject handed her a note and demanded money from the cash register and

implied he had a weapon. The owner, Prabhu Kasthurirangaian, was notified of the robbery. Police were able to view surveillance of the incident.

4. On 08/30/19 at 10:52pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1716 W. Layton Avenue (Room 146) for a fight complaint. Officer's interviewed an injured citizen who stated that he did not get into a physical altercation but "fell" in the hallway. A person in a neighboring room stated that the injured subject was in a physical fight with two unknown actors. While interviewing the suspected victim, officers observed that the sliding glass door to room 146 had a large piece of plywood on it and had exposed glass facing the exterior of the room. The clerk at the hotel said the glass had been broken for about a month and does not know when it will be repaired. A check of the "calls for service" showed that multiple calls regarding the tenants in rooms 146 and 148 because they often "fight" each other.
  5. On 09/22/19 at 11:26pm, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1716 W. Layton Avenue (Room 127) for a property damage complaint. Investigation revealed that an ex-boyfriend broke into room 127 through the patio window. The tenant in the room called the front desk who, in turn called the police. Police found the subject in room 146, told him he was not allowed at the hotel, and escorted him off the property. While police were still on scene, the subject returned to the location twice and was subsequently arrested. The manager worked well with officers and was able to provide them with information to help locate and identify the suspect.
  6. On 10/18/19 at 8:30am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1716 W. Layton Avenue for an armed robbery complaint. Investigation revealed that the alleged victim met a subject at the hotel for the purpose of prostitution. The manager was informed of the situation and he stated that he would not rent any more rooms to the subject.
  7. On 10/18/19 at 11:27pm, Milwaukee Police conducted an underage alcohol procurement at the address of 1716 W. Layton Avenue. During the "sting" and underage Police Aide was able to buy a bottle of beer from the bartender inside the tavern at that location. The bartender, Chahnsamay BOUNKET was cited.

8. On 11/02/19 at 1:37am, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to 1716 W. Layton Avenue for a threat complaint. Upon arrival, officers interviewed the caller who stated that he was assaulted by two males who told him that he was stalking the bartender inside the tavern of the establishment. Officers interviewed the bartender who stated that the caller frequents the tavern while she is working and tonight, he was parked in his vehicle, with his high beams shining through the window, staring at her. The bartender says that she told other patrons inside the tavern that she does not feel comfortable when the caller is around but denies that she told the two males to confront the caller. The caller was told that he was not welcome at the tavern, so he checked into the hotel for the next two days.

9. On 03/18/20 at 08:26pm, Milwaukee Police conducted a license premise check at 1716 W. Layton Avenue to see if the tavern at the establishment was in compliance with Emergency Order #5 (inside Executive Order #72). Upon entering the tavern, officers observed two patrons sitting at the bar and one of the subjects had a drink. Officers informed the bartender that per the Governor, people were not allowed to be inside any establishment that serves food or drink. The bartender was under the impression that people could have a drink at the bar when they were waiting for their food. The officers went over Executive Order #72 (Emergency Order #5) and the bartender understood the order and made sure they are immediately followed by asking both patrons to leave. The bartender was extremely cooperative in the past and was again during this encounter. The bartender was given a copy of Emergency Order #5 and the premise check was ended.
10. On 06/25/20 at 9:01pm Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a reckless use of a weapon complaint at Travel Lodge, located at 1716 W. Layton Av. Investigation determined that the assignment was a sick/injured complaint, that occurred in the parking lot of the business. Officer spoke with victim who stated that she was leaning on her boyfriend's vehicle and lost her balance after the car was in motion. When the boyfriend left the location he unintentionally ran over her arm causing the victim pain. The victim was conveyed to St Luke's hospital for medical treatment. Officers spoke with the on duty manager at the hotel who stated that he just started his shift and did not see the incident. The manger was advised by the prior manger about the incident. The business was cooperative with the investigation.
11. On 07/20/20 at 12:12am Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a trouble with subject complaint at Travel Lodge, located at 1716 W. Layton Av. Upon arrival officers spoke with the caller, a juvenile who stated that the issue was resolved. The caller did state that he did not agree with the way he was treated by the security, because he said a racial slur. Officers spoke with the on duty manager who stated that the hotel resolved the issue with juvenile and his mother, and that security did not use a racial slur. The manager stated that he was going to allow both subjects to stay the night but then have both subjects leave in the morning.
12. On 07/21/20 at 1:58am Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a theft complaint at Travel Lodge located at, 1716 W. Layton Av. The caller stated that an unknown female that he has invited to his room on serval occasions stole his phone and disappeared. The caller could not give officers any relevant information on the female. Officers spoke with the front desk employee who stated that the caller has been inviting the female over most of his 30 day stay at the hotel. The employee believes that the caller has been doing drugs in his room, and that he will be evicted after today's events. Officers were not allowed in the room by the caller. The business was cooperative with officers regarding the investigation.
13. On 08/27/20 at 5:56pm Milwaukee Police were dispatched to an injured/sick complaint at Travel Lodge, located at 1716 W. Layton Av. Officers met bell #445 with the caller in room #232 regarding. The caller stated that he was intoxicated and feeling depressed. The caller stated that he wanted to go to the hospital. The caller was conveyed by bell ambulance and police services were not needed.

14. On 09/08/20 at 1:00pm community officers from District 6 conducted a Safety and Security meeting at Travel Lodge, located at 1716 W. Layton Av. The officers were met by two managers of the business that did a walkthrough of the location. Discussed at the meeting were the hours of the onsite restaurant, the amount of security cameras, and the use of private security. Concerns covered were the amount of sick/ injured calls regarding over dose complaints. The management stated that any information regarding drug or prostitute use would get a renter band from the hotel. The renter would be placed on a do not rent list. Management told officers the hotel policy is to check ids, and vehicles associated with the renter. Officers were showed the current renter form with the required information. The management expressed that a main issue has been from long term stay renters. To help resolve those issues the hotel has only rented rooms on a day to day basis. Officers observed that some of the connecting buildings of the hotel are still under construction. This concluded the meeting.
15. On 10/09/20 at 3:24pm community officers from District 6 conducted a meeting at Travel Lodge, located at 1716 W. Layton Av., regarding an incident that occurred on 10/07/20. Officers spoke with the onsite managers regarding the incident in which drugs were located in the rented room. The managers were then given a Notice of Public Nuisance Drug Letter, and explained the contents of the letter. Management explained that the subject related to the complaint appeared to be under the influence of a drug when using the in lobby ATM. The manager on duty that day then put the renter on the Do Not Rent List. The management then showed officers the computer with the renter's information. Next to the information there was the letters DNR, and a brief comment regarding. This allows staff to be aware if a customer is on the Do Not Rent List , and not to rent any rooms to said person.
16. On 12/01/20 at 9:15pm Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a fight complaint at Travel Lodge, located at 1716 W. Layton Av. Officers spoke to the front desk who stated that renters in room 103 have been arguing all day and staff could not make contact with the renters. Officers spoke with subjects, they were advised to keep the noise down or they would be asked to leave the location. The hotel staff was cooperative and no violations were observed.
17. On 12/11/20 at 8:08 pm Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a threat complaint at Travel Lodge, located at 1716 W. Layton Av. Officers spoke with the caller who stated that he wanted to turn himself in on his warrant. The subject did have a valid warrant, a search incident to arrest revealed that the subject had items that appeared to be narcotics. The items were tested positive for methamphetamine and fentanyl. The subject was conveyed to District #6 to be processed.
18. On 12/13/20 at 4:03pm Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a child neglect complaint at Travel Lodge, located at 1716 W. Layton Av. Officers spoke with the manager on scene who stated that a 6 year old child came to the front desk and stated that she got locked out of the room. The manager asked the child where are your parents the child replied that they were not there. The manager then called the police regarding. Investigation revealed that the child was left in the care of a 16 year old and that the parent now at the location did not neglect the child.

19. On 12/16/ 20 at approximately 9:51pm Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a battery complaint at Travel Lodge, located at 1716 W. Layton Av. Officers spoke with the caller who stated that she met the suspect through Facebook, and had been talking to him for a while. The suspect took the caller to the outside of location and wanted to pay her for intercourse. The victim refused to go to the room and the suspect became angry striking the suspect in her arm pushing her out of his vehicle. The suspect left the location with some items belonging to the victim. Officers spoke with the front desk and were able to obtain the suspects information. The victim had minor pain and injures from the incident. The victim was then was conveyed home and given officers information along with a PV-17 form.
20. On 01/04/21 at 8:45pm Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a sick/injured complaint at Travel Lodge, located at 1716 W. Layton Av. Officers located a subject lying on the floor of the lobby of the hotel. Investigation determined that the subject is staying in room # 116 and became intoxicated at the bar attached to the hotel. Officers located the subject's live in friend with same address and phone, in the room. The friend stated that he would care for the subject's wellbeing. The hotel staff was cooperative and no violations were observed.
21. On 01/12/21 at 9:01pm Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a trouble with subject complaint at Travel Lodge, located at 1716 W. Layton Av. The caller indicated that the subject was in room #106, causing a disturbance and stealing items. The subjects inside the room refused police services. The business was cooperative with the investigation, no violations were observed.
22. On 01/19/21 at 5:02pm community officers from District 6 conducted a meeting at Travel Lodge, located at 1716 W. Layton Av. Officers spoke with the manager, James Perry and conducted a walkthrough of the hotel. Officers observed multiple exit/entrance doors, which were not secured due to faulty door brackets on the first floor. Mr. Perry stated to officers that new door brackets were ordered and hoped to have the brackets installed within the week or so. Mr. Perry stated that the hotel does have security at the location Monday-Thursday 10pm-6am, and are looking for a coverage Friday-Sunday for the same time frame. The third building of the location is still currently being renovated and should be completed within approximately two weeks. The third building is intended to be used for extended stay customers. Officers discussed dispatched calls from 10/22/20 to 01/19/21. The dispatched calls were 48 calls for service with 28 of those calls being dispatched assignments. Mr. Perry stated to officers that the business tries to handle all matters in house before altering the police. Mr. Perry stated to officers that the business had had serval issues of domestic violence, and changed policy that both parties of the room have to leave the establishment. This policy is to deter a return of potential problems. Officers observed security cameras operational at the time of the meeting. Mr. Perry was advised, officers would have quarterly meetings with business and discuss any issues regarding.
23. On 01/20/21 at 5:50pm Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a threat complaint at Travel Lodge, located at 1716 W. Layton Av. Officers responded to room 107, and could not make contact with the complainant. There was no answer at the door or answer on multiple call backs to the caller. No Violations were observed by officers while they were on scene.
24. On 02/09/21 Milwaukee Police were dispatched to Travel Lodge, located at 1716 W. Layton Av., for a Trouble with Subject. The caller stated they were in room #106 and an unknown subject was pounding on the door. On arrival no one was located in the hall near Room 106, and the occupants stated they did not call police. Management was notified and cooperative.

25. On 02/19/21, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to Travel Lodge, located at 1716 W. Layton Av., for a Welfare Check. The caller stated a friend of his that was staying at the hotel contacted him and was having a mental health crisis. On arrival police made contact with the subject, who was intoxicated and denied needing any assistance. The subject did not have any injuries and appeared to be in good health.
26. On 02/21/12, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to Travel Lodge, located at 1716 W. Layton Av., for a Burglary Investigation. On arrival it was determined a suspect grabbed a key card from the neck of a housekeeper, entered the victim's room and stole items worth approximately \$3100. Management and employees were cooperative with the investigation.
27. On 03/03/21, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to Travel Lodge, located at 1716 W. Layton Av., for a Sick and Injured Call. On arrival the caller declined any medical attention or police service and stated they had called for private transportation. The security officer at the hotel was cooperative and stated they would check on the guest periodically until the private transportation came.
28. On 03/04/21, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to Travel Lodge, located at 1716 W. Layton Av., for a Trouble with Subject in Room 218. On arrival officers did not hear any movement in the room, or signs of any guests in the room. Officers knocked several times; however, there was no answer at the door. The hotel clerk was notified and cooperative with police.
29. On 03/12/21, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to Travel Lodge, located at 1716 W. Layton Av., for a Trouble with Subject. Investigation revealed there were two guests that were loitering on the property after checking out. The guests were gone on Police arrival. Management was cooperative with Police.
30. On 03/15/21, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to Travel Lodge, located at 1716 W. Layton Av., for a Missing Check. On arrival it was determined the missing was not at the hotel. Later in the day officers conducted follow up at the hotel and were able to locate the missing in a hotel room. Management cooperated with the investigation.
31. On 03/19/21, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to Travel Lodge, located at 1716 W. Layton Av., for a Battery complaint. Officers were advised there was an individual bleeding from the nose, kicking the door to a room and blood all over the hallway. The employee stated the individual was yelling and threatening guests, causing them to fear for their safety. The individual was located and arrested.
32. On 03/19/21, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to Travel Lodge, located at 1716 W. Layton Av., for a Battery complaint. The employee/caller stated a known suspect came to the location and cut both rear tires of her vehicle two days ago, and again on 03/19/21. Investigation revealed the employees' statements to be contradictory to a report filed previously and video surveillance observed by the police, however, she was provided with information on a restraining order.
33. On 03/23/21, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to Travel Lodge, located at 1716 W. Layton Av., for a Trouble with Subject. On arrival the caller stated the subject left and police were no longer needed.

34. On 03/28/21, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to Travel Lodge, located at 1716 W. Layton Av., for a Dead on Entry. Officers were met by MFD and investigation did not indicate any foul play was involved. It was determined this was a probable drug overdose.
35. On 03/23/21, Milwaukee Police were dispatched to Travel Lodge, located at 1716 W. Layton Av., for a Threat complaint. On arrival officers were advised by the manager they wanted a hotel guest removed from the premise due to being loud and using profanities. The guest was located and removed from the establishment.

36. On 04/20/2021 at 12:06am officers were dispatched to a Threat complaint at the Travel Lodge, 1716 W. Layton Av. The officers were advised the clerk was reporting a subject was in the lobby making threats. When officers arrived the subject was gone and the clerk was uncooperative with the officers. The clerk refused to identify herself and was advised she could receive a citation for Disorderly Conduct based on the statements she made to the 911 operator.
37. On 05/27/2021 at 2:05am officers were dispatched to a Sick and Injured complaint at the Travel Lodge, 1716 W. Layton Av. The officer spoke with the caller who stated she might have been drugged but she is not sure because she consumed a lot of alcohol. The officers called for medical treatment but she refused. The officers escorted the female to her room. The officers attempted to locate an employee for the business but there was no one available.
38. On 05/28/2021 at 12:26am officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at the Travel Lodge, 1716 W. Layton Av. The officers spoke with a tenant, who stated her room had an adjoining door to the room next door. She stated she saw the door moving like someone was attempting to get inside. The officers observed the rooms were being renovated and suggested she get a different room. The manager was able to relocate the caller.
39. On 06/12/2021 at 7:42pm officers were dispatched to a Call for Police at the Travel Lodge, 1716 W. Layton Av. The officer went to the room number listed for the caller but were unable to locate him.
40. On 06/14/2021 at 11:24pm officers were dispatched to a Battery at the Travel Lodge, 1716 W. Layton Av. room #146. The officer determined there was no battery but the occupants were just being loud and yelling. The subjects were advised to keep the noise down or they would be kicked out.
41. On 06/19/2021 officers were dispatched to a DOE at the Travel Lodge, 1716 W. Layton Av. The officers met MFD, who was on scene with a deceased subject. The officers interviewed the hotel manager who stated the subject was staying for 6 days and when he did not check out they checked his room and found him deceased. There was no foul play suspected.
42. On 06/27/2021 at 10:55pm officers were dispatched to a Battery at the Travel Lodge, 1716 W. Layton Av. The officers spoke with the caller, who stated he was upset because he was over charged. He stated a security guard pushed him out of the lobby and he wanted to press charges. The security guard stated the subject was yelling at the clerk. The clerk refunded his money and he continued to cause a scene and was refusing to leave. The security guard then escorted him out.

43. On 06/29/2021 at 11:11am officers were dispatched to an Overdose at the Travel Lodge, 1716 W. Layton Av. The officer spoke with the caller, who stated her boyfriend was overdosing on heroin. The subject refused medical attention from MFD and refused to speak with officers. The officer did not observe any evidence of drug use. The caller stated she would stay with her boyfriend to monitor his condition.
44. On 07/19/2021 at 1:47am officers were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at the Travel Lodge, 1716 W. Layton Av. The caller stated he did not like how he was treated by security at the location. The officers spoke with security who stated the subject was sitting in the lobby and he asked him to leave. There was no hotel clerk working to check in the caller and security does not have access to check customers in.
45. On 07/31/2021 at 10:21pm officers were dispatched to a Battery at the Travel Lodge, 1716 W. Layton Av. The officers spoke with a security guard, who stated he confronted a subject on the property. He stated the subject reached behind his back and stated "I got a bullet for you". The security guard stated he grabbed the subject by the neck and "handled business". The subject was located several blocks away and was found to have severe injuries requiring medical treatment. The officers located a witness who observed the guard striking the subject with a baton to the ribs and head. The agent arrived to operate the video system but he did not have a required passcode. The guard was arrested for Substantial Battery.
46. On 08/09/2021 at 10:32pm officers were dispatched to a Theft at the Travel Lodge, 1716 W. Layton Av. The officer spoke with the caller, who stated her cell phone was missing and she "pinged" it. She located it in room #103 but the occupants refused to return the phone. The officers went to the room and the occupants denied having the phone. The caller did not want a police report.
47. On 08/22/2021 at 2:42pm officers were dispatched to a Battery at the Travel Lodge, 1716 W. Layton Av. The officers interviewed the victim, who stated she has been living with a subject at the hotel for the last five months. The subject battered her and choked her today. The victim was conveyed to the hospital for treatment.
48. On 09/24/2021 at 8:58pm officers were dispatched to a Property Damage at the Travel Lodge, 1716 W. Layton Av. There was multiple squads involved during the incident. Squad 6311 was Sergeant Joshua SEIDL, Squad 6330 was Police Officers Jacob GUERRERO and Rafael LOPEZ, Squad 6340 was Police Officer Omar PEDROZA-BELTRAN, Squad 9316 was Sergeant Joseph LANZA, and Squads 9361, 9367 were Detectives Nora DONEGAN and Corey HARRIS.

Upon arrival, we observed an infant laying unconscious, not breathing on a bed with MFD trying to resuscitate the infant. We then spoke to the biological father of the victim identified as Cornelius S WILLIAMS b/m DOB 04-30-1984. WILLIAMS stated he arrived at the hotel at around 10pm of last night. WILLIAMS stated he had been working long hours at taco bell stating they were understaffed and was too tired to drive home. WILLIAMS stated prior to him falling asleep his daughter was in his mother's arms and does not remember anything else.

WILLIAMS stated at around 4:09am his daughter's mother, Chandeliere Jackson, woke him up, that she was holding his daughter and stated his daughter was not breathing.

We also spoke to the biological mother of the victim identified as Chandeliere L JACKSON b/f DOB 10-8-2004. JACKSON stated that on 06/23/2025 at around 11:00pm she stepped outside into the patio, had a cigarette and after having something to eat and before laying down in the bed to go to sleep she checked on her baby and observed her chest rise what would appear for her baby to be breathing.

JACKSON stated Cornelius WILLIAMS was laying on the left side of the bed, the baby was laying on the right side of the bed when she laid toward the foot of the bed perpendicular to them both. JACKSON states she woke up around 4:00am to check on her baby and she was not breathing. JACKSON states she then called 911.

On Thursday 9-11-25 at approximately 12:50AM while in full duty uniform wearing an Axon 3 body worn camera and operating a marked MPD squad. I responded to the location of 1716 W Layton Ave (Travelodge Motel) for a Theft Complaint later determined to be a Burglary Complaint.

I spoke with the victim identified as Sharon L. HEJDAK (W/F 12-12-56) who stated that on 9-10-25 at 6:00PM she entered her room #137 and closed the door leading to the parking lot. It should be noted that this room has 2 doors one leads to the hallway inside the motel and the other leads to the parking lot. HEJDAK then proceeds to engage in a phone call with a friend she identifies as Nancy TESTDORF. HEJDAK stated that after ending the conversation with TESTDORF she fell asleep. HEJDAK stated that she then woke up and observed an individual inside her room taking her purse, car keys, and cellphone. HEJDAK stated that she could only see his back but described him as being approximately 5'05, 150lbs, wearing a checkered white and black sweatshirt with the hood up. HEJDAK then observed the suspect walk out of the room and enter her vehicle which she described as a black 2005 Nissan Altima WI Plate #ANT4752 and drive away. HEJDAK stated that she then looked over her room to see what was missing other than her keys and identified that her purse containing \$214 of U.S. Currency, 8 bottles of medication, and her cellphone was taken. When asked about her medication she was unable to remember the exact name of most of the medication. HEJDAK then stated that her vehicle was filled with her property which she valued at approximately \$5625 worth of Miscellaneous items. In total \$8919 was taken from the hotel room occupied by HEJDAK intentionally and without consent.

ALCAUTER stated she met a white man on snapchat who goes by "TONI" (snapchat: Toni7ii) planned on taking her to a concert at "THE ROCK" sports complex located at 7044 S Ball Park drive located in the City of Franklin in Milwaukee County. ALCAUTER took a uber from Chicago Heights, Illinois to attend the concert with "TONI". At no point in time did "TONI" show ALCAUTER the tickets. "TONI" stated he was going to keep ALCAUTER at a "nice hotel" and ended up placing her at the travel lodge since "TONI" lived with his mother.

Upon arrival to the hotel at approximately 10:11 P.M the night prior via Uber after 1 hour of 50 minute car ride "TONI" did not come to the hotel lobby to escort ALCAUTER to room 228. ALCAUTER thought that was suspicious. ALCAUTER stated when she entered the room something felt off and wrong. The suspect, "TONI" was acting different, giving her one worded answers and was not being his normal self which was much more social. ALCAUTER and "TONI" wanted to go to the CLARK gas station to get a phone charger to charge her phone. The gas station was clearly closed. "TONI" asked ALCAUTER to go check and try to open the business door. ALCAUTER exited the motor vehicle described only as a silver sedan. Since KAMERI paid cash he provided his identification via United States Passport. Which was scanned in by the front desk clerk. When I showed ALCAUTER the photo from Department of Transportation (DOT) and the passport photo ALCAUTER stated "yep, that is him".

At this time ALCAUTER is wanting to prosecute

At approximately 7:24 A.M I had the acting desk sergeant Officer Amos FERGUSON send a teletype to the City of South Milwaukee Police Department to locate the subject who was positively identified as Veton KAMERI (M/W 03/21/2002) who resides at the address of 120 8th Avenue located in the City of South Milwaukee in Milwaukee County. Officer WILLIAMSON of the South Milwaukee Police Department contacted me at 8:50 A.M letting me know they made door contact and spoke with the father of KAMERI. The father was identified as Alidi ILER. The father stated he kicked his son out a year ago due to
