Resolution recognizing Milwaukee County bus driver, Tayetta Currin, for stopping to help a pregnant woman who was in labor on Christmas Eve.

WHEREAS,

TAYETTA CURRIN

was driving her Milwaukee County Transit System bus route when she saw a pregnant woman who needed help on a snowy sidewalk on Christmas Eve, December 24, 2017; and

WHEREAS, *Tayetta Currin demonstrated compassion and quick thinking and was able to help the woman, who was pregnant and in labor; and*

WHEREAS, *Tayetta Currin was able to bring the woman onto her bus and called for an ambulance to come help the woman who was having contractions and needed to get to a hospital; and*

WHEREAS, *Tayetta Currin has two children of her own and was able to recognize the situation as an emergency, called 911, and kept the woman calm and warm inside the bus while emergency medical technicians arrived; and*

WHEREAS, *Tayetta Currin's actions helped the woman get to the hospital to receive the care she needed; and*

WHEREAS, *Tayetta Currin has a history of stopping to help others including a shooting victim after a robbery, and often goes above and beyond on her job; now, therefore, be it*

RESOLVED, *That the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee herewith recognizes and thanks Tayetta Currin for her valiant actions, and her compassionate and brave service to the community; and, be it*
