2010 Proposed Changes/Issues

- Reduced funding for 2 Port Maintenance Technician positions (-2.0 FTEs)
- Added 1 Graduate Assistant position (.5 FTE)
- Increased Professional Services for consultant to assist in developing revenue projections and capital needs -\$50,000

Other Policy & Service Issues

- Special Funds
 - Eliminated for dock wall and breakwater rehabilitation
 - Reduced funding for energy efficiency upgrades

Capital Funds Authority

- No capital funds provided in the 2010 capital budget.
 - \$5.8 million in authority outstanding
 - Outstanding funding sufficient cover new and current projects
 - Projects need to be closed out
 - Explanation for not completing projects

2010 Proposed Budget

- Allows the Port to remain fully functional
- Graduate Intern to assist in Marketing and Finance
- Increase in Professional Services Account to fund research into potential future revenues
- Capital authority is still available for Port complete necessary capital projects
