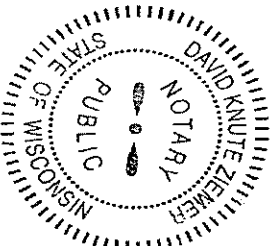

Substitute resolution approving levy-
ing of assessments and construction of
assessable public improvement projects
at various locations and appropriating
funds for these purposes with the City
cost of these projects approved by this
resolution is estimated to be
\$9,207,000 for a total estimated cost
of \$9,853,700.

Whereas, The Common Council of
the City of Milwaukee adopted prelimi-
nary resolutions, determining it neces-
sary and in the public interest to con-
struct and levy special assessments for
the following improvements:

**2nd Aldermanic District
N. 74th St. - W. Hampton Ave.
to W. Fairmount Ave.
(ST211020106) File Number
020390:** Asphalt pavement resurfac-
ing, replace curb and gutter, sidewalk
and driveway approaches where neces-
sary, sodding (7-foot width of tree bor-
der area), and grading. (Assessable Re-
construction Paving Fund — \$1,000;
Nonassessable Reconstruction Paving
Fund — \$141,300). The total estimated
cost for this project including the re-
quested amount is \$158,000. This pro-
ject is anticipated to be completed dur-
ing the 2009 construction season.

**2nd and 7th
Aldermanic Districts
N. 51st Blvd. - W. Roosevelt
Dr. to W. Capitol Dr.
(ST211070103) File Number
061097:** Concrete pavement recon-
struction, replace all curb and gutter,
sidewalk and driveway approaches

tion Paving Fund — \$131,000). The total
estimated cost for this project including
the requested amount is \$160,000. This
project is anticipated to be completed
during the 2009 construction season.

ing, replace curb and gutter, sidewalk
and driveway approaches where neces-
sary, sodding (width of tree border

Reconstruction Paving Fund —

\$107,000). The total estimated cost for

amount is \$140,000. This project is an-
ticipated to be completed during the

construction Paving Fund — \$5,000;
Nonassessable Reconstruction Paving
Fund — \$155,000). The total estimated
cost for this project including the re-
quested amount is \$184,000. This pro-
ject is anticipated to be completed dur-
ing the 2009 construction season.

Number 070084:** Asphalt pavement
resurfacing, replace curb and gutter,
sidewalk and driveway approaches
where necessary, sodding (7.8-foot

Fund — \$12,000; Nonassessable Recon-
struction Paving Fund — \$165,000). The
total estimated cost for this project in-
cluding the requested amount is
\$194,000. This project is anticipated to
be completed during the 2009 construc-
tion season.

and in the manner directed by Section
115-42 of the Milwaukee Code of Ord-
nances; and be it

Further Resolved, That the proper
departments take such action as is re-
quired of them to assess the dubiting or
adjacent properties and collect such as-
sessment in the manner directed by Sec-
tion 115-42 of the Milwaukee Code of
Ordinances; and be it

Further Resolved, That the City
Comptroller is authorized and directed
to transfer such funds which are avail-
able for this purpose to the appropriate
capital Project/Grant accounts; and be
it

Further Resolved, That the projects
do not involve any parcels of agricul-
tural land which are eligible for de-
ferred special assessments under the
provisions of Section 14.30 of the Mil-
waukee City Charter; and be it

Further Resolved, That the City Engi-
neer and the Commissioner of Public
Works are hereby authorized to nego-
tiate and enter into an agreement with
the State of Wisconsin, Department of
Transportation for the City to under-
take construction management duties on
the following project: W. Forest Home
Ave. (STH 24) (ST320071301); and, be it
Further Resolved, That the City Engi-
neer is authorized and directed to op-
prove and make periodic payments to
the State of Wisconsin, Department of
Transportation after receipt of invoices
from said State for the city's share of
the costs for said project: W. Forest
Home Ave. (ST320071301); and, be it

Further Resolved, That upon the com-
pletion of project: W. Forest Home Ave.
(ST320071301) and a determination of
the actual costs, it is understood that if
the City of Milwaukee's share is less
than the amount previously paid, the
difference will be returned to said City;
and be it

Further Resolved, That the Depart-
ment of Public Works is authorized to
use the funding as specified in the
above description of work; and, be it

Further Resolved, That projects N.

(ST211070104), N. 51st Blvd.
