Dear Sir or Ms.:

There had been some excavation work done around the year 2000 by the City of Milwaukee directly in front of our house. We have had problems ever since. We have had back ups on our sinks and toilets, which include bubbling up. On July 26, 2001 we had Flat-Rate Plumbing come to open our lateral going to the main line. They took a camera through the line and found a breakage in the lateral line right next to the main line at 40'. At this time it occurred to us that the digging beforehand may have caused this, Flat Rate did have someone from the City of Milwaukee look at the video, and he acknowledged the situation. As time went on we have had more and more problems, which in the mean while we had bubbling up in the sinks and toilets. We tried Roto Rooting but the problem was it would just bubble up through the sinks and toilets. We had Plumbing doctors come out for free to try and roto root the problem and this helped for a while until we finally started having major back ups through the drain in our basement of raw human sewage. Not to mention it was a mess I had never seen before in a home. We were constantly picking this up and placing it into plastic bags, use of any cleaning materials possible was used for the unbearable odor and we were forced to go to a motel for three days because of it. We then had Plumbing Doctors come out and look at this situation again and the plumber had tried to clean it another time. He had taken a camera through the line and plumber and myself, Ty N. Pendergast, had seen that the problem was worse because more toilet paper had hung on to the breakage, and the breakage looked worse. The Plumber tried to clean it, it worked for two weeks and then we had the real problem again, we had sewage back-up. We had to rent a motel for 2 days, again, clean it up night and day w bleach, chlorine etc. There is no price for that. It was just outright gross. The City of Milwaukee came out and sought to see if there was fault but never looked at the lines because they never dug far enough to see the breakage which was only 2' away from where they finished. They said that from what they dug in the past did not affect us and that we would have to hire our own private plumber to fix the problem. After 20 years of being in construction I felt they were wrong because they were digging in a different direction the first time they were there and I know from excavating 100 jobs in my time that it does not take much pressure to break clay tile.

Finally, I had Plumbing Doctors come and totally fix the problem, which they did. After Plumbing Doctors dug up the area where the problem was they had found problems on the main line. They had an inspector come out and look at the situation, his name is Bill Jaworski. We have a video tape, pictures, bills from the plumbing jobs and permit reports. Costs:





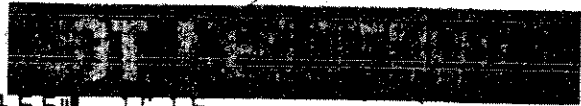

This permit is granted on condition that the Permittee will obey all sections of Chapter 115 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances and all specifications, rules and regulations of the Department of Public Works pertaining to this permit. The acceptance of this permit constitutes an acknowledgment and acceptance of the conditions and regulations noted below.

Barricading and signing: Barricades and signs shall comply with City of Milwaukee Dept. of Public Works manual "Traffic Control for Construction & Maintenance Work" and Part VI of the State of Wisconsin "Manual on Uniform Traffic Control Devices."

Occupying street: Materials must be kept at least 2 feet away from any tree, alarm box, manhole and catch basin. Materials and equipment must be kept at least 10 feet from fire hydrants, 15 feet from crosswalks, and in accordance with other restrictions of the Code of Ordinances.

Drainage and erosion control: Gutters and drainage ditches shall be kept open at all times and shall be restored to their original condition. Perform all work necessary to conform to Chapter 260, Erosion Control, Milwaukee Code of Ordinances.

Blocking roadway: Unless the permit specifically allows, you may not block the entire roadway.

Revocation of permit: The Commissioner of Public Works reserves the right to revoke this permit at any time if, in his or her judgment, it is in the best interest of the City of Milwaukee.

Guarantee: You must reimburse the City of Milwaukee for all damages to any city property resulting from your work. You must hold the City of Milwaukee harmless in case of any accident or any damages arising through the issuance of this permit, regardless of whether such damage or accident is caused by you, your agents, employees, or sub-contractors. In addition to the aforesaid provisions, said bond shall guarantee all work for 3 years from the date of completion thereof.

Lawn restoration: Where excavations in the sidewalk area or median destroy, disturb or damage the established lawn, the permittee or contractor shall restore the area with top grade nursery sod approved by the Commissioner of Public Works laid over 3 inches of screened top soil spread evenly over the entire area.

New pavement: Permit will be issued to excavate any street pavement or resurfaced street less than 3 years old only upon showing that an emergency exists.

Emergency services: Any person who fails to keep the location for which this permit is issued in a safe condition at all times will be billed for any emergency work performed by city forces in order to make the location safe.

Damage during excavation: Use care during excavation to avoid damage to existing structures or facilities. If any existing building structure or facility is damaged, notify the owner of the structure or facility immediately, and report the damage to the owner in writing within 24 hours. If the owner is the City of Milwaukee, report damage to the Commissioner, Dept. of Public Works, (414) 286-3300.

Obstructions: Unless you have permission to remove or relocate underground structures or facilities, you must work in a manner that minimizes disturbance of underground structures or facilities. Protect and support such facilities in accordance with the current specifications on file in the office of the Commissioner and all applicable laws.

Backfilling: All sand or gravel used to backfill excavations must meet current City specifications.

Flushing: All backfill in excavations must be thoroughly flushed, unless controlled, compacted or concrete aggregate quarry backfill is used.

Temporary surfacing: The top 3" of excavations in any public way shall be a bituminous material. Place the bituminous material flush with the surrounding surface within 72 hours after backfilling has been completed.

Excavated material: Do not place excavated material on double seal, single seal, crushed stone, graded aggregate, or gravel pavements.

Restoration of street: Perform the work promptly and professionally. Remove all refuse and excess dirt and materials from the surface of the public way as the work progresses or immediately upon its completion. Restoration must be done in accordance with current specifications.

Guarantee (roadway excavation): THE PERMITTEE MUST GUARANTEE THE MAINTENANCE OF THE TEMPORARY SURFACING ON ALL EXCAVATIONS BETWEEN EXISTING OR PROPOSED CURB LINES FOR 6 MONTHS, EXCEPT THAT ANY PERMITTEE ALLOWED TO MAKE PERMANENT RESTORATION TO AN EXCAVATION SHALL BE RESPONSIBLE FOR ALL MAINTENANCE FOR A PERIOD OF 3 YEARS AFTER PERMANENT RESTORATION IS COMPLETED.

Guarantee (back of curb excavation): THE PERMITTEE SHALL GUARANTEE THE FILLED EXCAVATION BETWEEN EXISTING OR PROPOSED CURB LINE AND LOT LINE AGAINST SETTLEMENT FOR 3 YEARS.

Sidewalks: Sidewalk, curb and curb and gutter are to be constructed according to current specifications of Infrastructure Services division and with current specifications on file in the office of the Commissioner, and guaranteed according to these specifications.

Changing grade: No person shall alter the grade of any public way or public place unless authorized or directed to do so.

Correction of improper construction: Whenever an installation is constructed in violation of this permit, the Commissioner may order such installation to be removed and properly placed if the permittee refuses to do as ordered, the Commissioner shall cause the necessary work to be done and charge the permittee for the work.

Hollow sidewalks: Construction or alteration of hollow sidewalks must be in accordance with plans approved by Infrastructure Services division and with current specifications on file in the office of the Commissioner.

Lawn restoration: Where excavations in the sidewalk area or median destroy, disturb or damage the established lawn the permittee or contractor shall restore the area with top grade nursery sod approved by the Commissioner of Public Works laid over 3 inches of screened top soil spread evenly over the entire area.

Except for emergency excavations, excavation permit is void if permittee does not contact Diggers Hotline (259-1181) at least three working days prior to digging. Notify fire department dispatcher any time road is closed: 286-8999. Call traffic operations (286-3632) for "Temporary no parking" signs.
