WHEREAS,

KRISTINA FUNG

was recognized as a 2026 AAPI Honoree at the Asian American Pacific Islander Heritage Month kick-off event at City Hall on Friday, May, 1; and

WHEREAS, *Asian American and Pacific Islander honorees enrich the community through commitment to their cultural heritage while finding ways to connect, belong, and grow alongside it shaping its future success and enhancing its cultural landscape; and*

WHEREAS, *Kristina “Krissie” Fung is committed to equity, transparency, and community-driven solutions in relationships in her professional work as a member of the Board of Fire and Police Commissioners as well as her extensive community work with the Milwaukee Turners, Zero Youth Corrections, Comprehensive Injury Center at the Medical College of Wisconsin, and Japanese American Citizens League of Wisconsin; and*

WHEREAS, *Krissie Fung draws on her own life experiences as a non-binary Chinese (Cantonese) person with family roots in Hong Kong and Wisconsin to be a bridge between the community and institutions striving for the transparency and accountability.; and*

WHEREAS, *Krissie Fung promotes civic education initiatives and criminal legal system reform work through cross-sector collaboration across the greater Milwaukee area earning her recognition from the Milwaukee Business Journal and Madison365; now therefore be it*
