File # 050381 is a resolution relative to the application, acceptance and funding of the Road Crew Grant.

Background

- 1. This resolution authorizes the Milwaukee Health Department (MHD) to apply for, accept and fund the Road Crew grant from the Wisconsin Department of Transportation (DOT).
- 2. This is a new grant.

Discussion

- 1. The purpose of this pilot program is to design and market a program, in a specified area of the city, which will charge tavern owners and customers for transportation home. The Wisconsin DOT is seeking alternatives to tavern customers driving while intoxicated
- 2. The project area is located in the 13th Aldermanic District and includes 16 taverns in the airport area on Howell, Morgan and Oklahoma Avenues.
- 3. MHD is the fiscal agent for this program and will monitor and authorize payments to the program coordinator. A limousine service will be provided for participating taverns with the service paid for by the customer and the tavern.
- 4. A six-month set up period is planned (to May 3, 2006) with a one-year operational period (May 2006 through April 30, 2007).
- 5. Evaluation of this pilot program will be measured by the number of participants, fees charged and other outcomes obtained.
- 6. The program will include a community coalition, not yet identified, an oversight committee, a fiscal monitoring group and a program coordinator.
- 7. This grant encompasses the period of November 3, 2005 through April 30, 2007.

Fiscal Effect

- 1. The total amount of this grant is \$35,000, entirely from the grantor.
- 2. Program supplies and services are budgeted for \$17,000.

3. Another \$18,000 is budgeted for a contract to develop the project coordination.
