Please note the following message sent in less than 24 hours. It is my suspicion that this message is sent in retaliation for the letters we are sending in opposition to these ordinances. I also suspect that this is a way to limit how residents glean information. I have seen meetings rescheduled; however, there have been a couple of changes to this event since our meetings and calls.

It is with your swift, immediate, and authority of the law that you enforce that this meeting and future meeting scheduled for Feb 1, 2025 are shared via channel 25 and on spectrum as well as keep the door open for attendance. These actions by the Council are pointing to an inquisition and breach of public trust as it implies that something unwarranted is taking place. Transparency is required on these very important matters.

The overwhelming flood of emotions and dissipated trust in operations of the City of Milwaukee and its openness causes emotional trauma and a disheartenment that I cannot explain. This sudden closure of opportunity to watch and give input on a critically important matter causes me to wonder if the elected representatives are clearly responding to our needs or those of other forces. The very fibers of the representative democracy and participatory governance that I previously complimented is crushed within enacting this one step.

I trust that you contact the members and deciding persons as well as the Mayor and reverse this knee jerk punitive action.
