- Usual 80% Federal/State funded with 20% local share

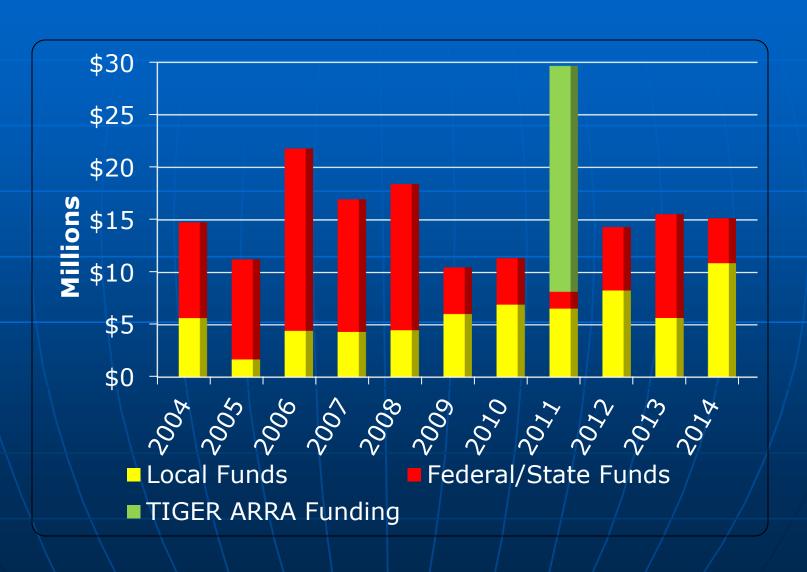
Bridge Local Program

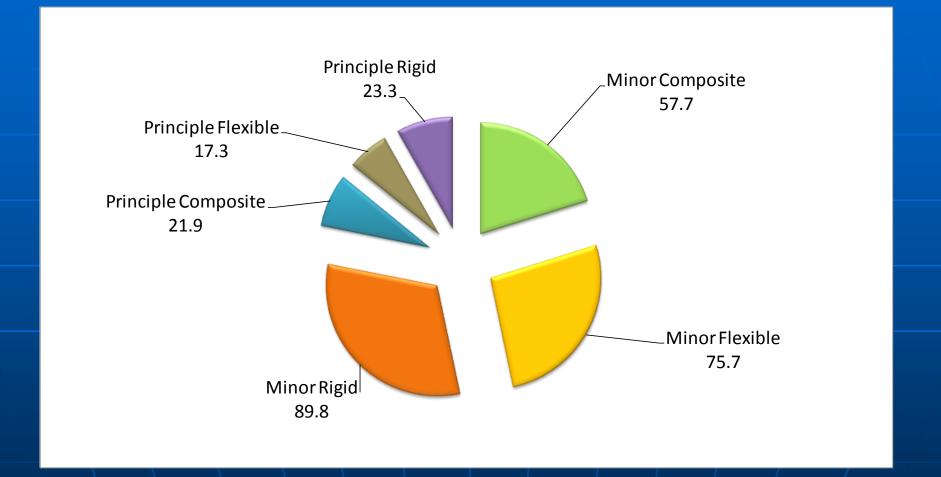

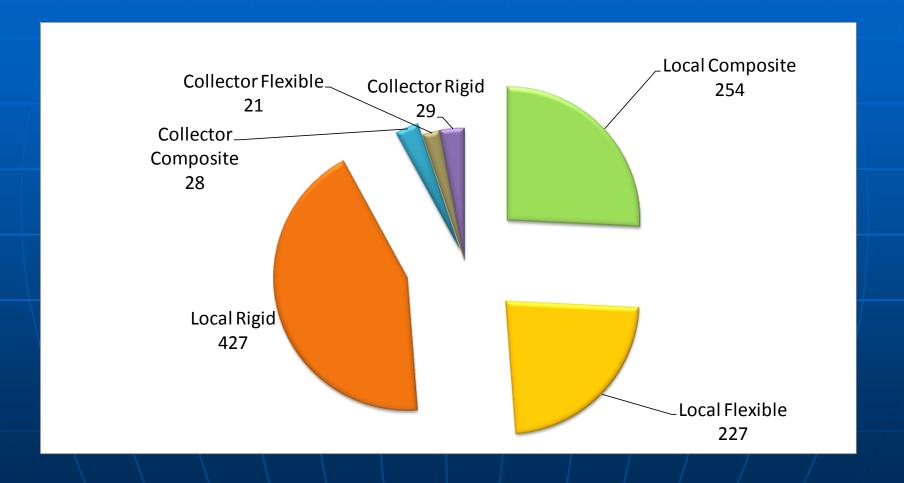
