Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines: Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to attend this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants and partnership applicants must attend or attend by an attorney. The agent or attorney for corporate or limited liability applicants must attend. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition attend the virtual hearing and are willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should request an interpreter attend the meeting with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

It showed them grabbing the purse and exiting the bar, walking

westbound. The manager was not able to make a copy of the video but stated they would email the officer a copy when the general manager arrived.

This report was written by PO Eric NORTHWOOD assigned to District 1 Late Power shift. On Friday, January 03, 2020 at 8:50 PM, I was dispatched to The Wicked Hop located at 345 N. Broadway for a theft.

INTERVIEW WITH VICTIM LEAH A. GRABOW (W/F 02-22-85)

Upon arrival I met with GRABOW who was sitting at a high top bar table located at the entrance of Wicked Hop.

GRABOW stated she arrived at Wicked Hop around 6:45 PM and when she left the table to go to the bathroom, she left her purse on one of the chairs. When she came back to the table she noticed that her wallet was gone from inside her purse. GRABOW did not give anyone permission to steal her wallet or its contents.

GRABOW spoke with the Bar Manager Haley E. KORABIK (W/F 03-19-94) who was able to check video and observe 3 black male suspects, standing by the railing at the entrance of the bar right by their table. One of the suspects looks over the railing a few times, then bends down and reaches inside of GRABOW'S purse. The suspect stands up and the three of them left the bar and proceeded to walk westbound on E. St. Paul Av. While the three suspects left, it appeared that suspect that removed the wallet started going through GRABOW'S property.

INTERVIEW WITH HALEY E. KORABIK (W/F 03-19-94)

I spoke with KORABIK who showed me the video of the incident; however she was unable to download video. KORABIK stated that the General Manager is able to download video, so I left my email with KORABIK and they will forward me video and pictures of the incident. I was also able to observe suspect 1 bend down and reach into GRABOW'S purse. Suspect 2 and 3 attempted to shield Suspect 1 while he was stealing the wallet.

Suspect 1: Black male, 5'7"-5'10", medium build, 175-190 pounds, winter jacket, and knit hat.

Suspect 2: Black male, 5'7"-5'10", medium build, 175-190 pounds, Dark winter jacket with fur hood, dark pants and dark shoes

Suspect 3: Black male, 5'6"-5'10", medium build, 175-190 pounds, winter hat, long black winter jacket, black pants, and white athletic shoes

GRABOW stated the following items were removed from her purse:

Black and Brown Coach Tri-fold Wallet: \$500

Approximately \$300 in US Currency, unknown denominations

Capitol One credit Card

Associated Bank Debit Card

Social Security Card

Wisconsin Driver's License

GRABOW stated that she already called and cancelled her Credit and Debit Cards.

I issued GRABOW a PV-17 and advised her to call me if she had any further information regarding the theft. I also issued her a Community Contact Card with my information on it.

After I was done speaking with GRABOW and KORABIK I walked around the area checking the garbage cans and dumpsters to see if any of GRABOW's property could be located. I did not find any of her possessions.

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place virtually on 1/26/2021 at 10:50 AM. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at <http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel>. Those wishing to provide oral testimony will be asked to do so by phone or internet and are asked to contact the staff assistant, Molly Kuether-Steele at (414) 286-2775 or molly.kuether-steele@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.
