Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

This report is written by Police Officer Gilbert Gwinn, assigned to the License Investigation Unit, Days.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 04/09/07, applicant received a citation for Building Code Violations at 2651 N 21st Street.

2. On 04/29/07 at 1:10 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 3530 W Silver Spring for a Theft complaint. Officers spoke to the bartender, Kevin Culver, who stated at approximately 12:20 am, two males and two females entered the tavern and were asked for ID. The males became upset, reached behind the bar and removed four bottles of alcohol. The four subjects then left the tavern with the bottles of liquor. The area was checked for these suspects but police were unable to locate anyone matching the descriptions. A report was filed.

3. On 06/17/07 at 2:30 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 3530 W Silver Spring for a Shooting complaint. Officers found a male patron who was shot inside the tavern after having an argument with another patron earlier that night. The suspect fled the scene before police arrived.

4. On 06/18/07 at 11:09 pm, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 3530 W Silver Spring for an Armed Robbery complaint. Officers spoke to the bartender Kevin Culver who stated an unknown male entered the tavern, implied he had a gun, and stole a bottle of liquor. Officers observed video cameras on the premises but were told they were not taping. Attempts to make contact with licensee, Terry Heinemeier, were unsuccessful. A report was filed.

5. On 10/03/07 at 1:23 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 3530 W Silver Spring for a Fight complaint. Investigation found that an unknown male was behind the bar and was asked to leave by a security guard, identified only as Schultz. This subject and several other males then jumped on Schultz punching him in the face. Schultz stated he did not know who was punching him. Officers also interviewed the bartender Elsie Lindert who stated she did not notice anything until after the fight broke out. Lindert stated the subjects who were fighting then left the tavern. Police attempted to contact the licensee, Terry Heinemeier, who was not home but officers left a voicemail message with instructions to contact the officers. The owner never called back. Police were told that the surveillance system in the tavern was not functional.

6. On 12/05/07 at 5:54 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 3530 W Silver Spring for an Armed Robbery complaint. Police spoke to Heidi Meyer who works for the Silver Spring Tap. Meyer stated three armed suspects approached her while she was in her auto and forced her to open the side door to the tavern. In there, she was told to give them the money from the till. Meyer stated the suspects then demanded money from the safe located in the back room. Meyer told them she didn't have the combination and the suspects pushed her into the back room attempting to lock her in. The actors fled out of the bar in an unknown direction. No injuries were reported.

The bartender Kevin Culver did not have his bartender's license on his person, however, it was on the premise in a locker. Also observed was an expired PEP license for the games that the property had. Culver stated he did not know how to turn them off and chose to close the bar.

18. On 07/29/12 at 1:33 am, Milwaukee police were dispatched to 3530 W Silver Spring for a Trouble With Subject complaint. Investigation revealed a subject was inside the bar refusing to leave. Police arrived and escorted the patron out. A wanted check revealed the subject had a warrant and was also found to be in possession of marijuana. PA-33E Narrative

This report is written by P.O. Nichole Evans assigned to District 4 Late Shift, Squad 4365. On Tuesday March 10, 2015 at 1:56 AM my partner P.O. Russell Shoup and I were dispatched to The Silver Spring Tap located at 3550 W. Silver Spring Dr in the City and County of Milwaukee, WI to Investigate a Fight Complaint / Subject with gun.

Upon arrival I conducted a sweep of the inside of the tavern to determine if there were any injuries to any of the patrons and to further conduct my investigation. Once inside I was advised by the manager on scene that there was no gun involved, no injuries sustained, and that that the subjects that were involved left the location.

I spoke with the (Manager) on scene Kevin S. Culver W/M 10-7-67 who stated that he is the bartender at the location and that the patrons were socializing, drinking, and enjoying themselves. Kevin stated that around 1:35 AM a altercation broke out between a b/f and a b/m at the bar. Kevin stated that the male was upset with the female and was accusing her of stealing his change from off the bar. Kevin stated that the male subject started to pat the women down in attempt to locate his change at which time a fight broke out inside the tavern at the entrance door with the male subject and two other b/m subjects that were believed to have been with the female.

Kevin stated that once the subjects left the location he closed the tavern, locked the doors, and then turned off the lights while several other customers waited inside. Kevin stated a short time later some subjects returned to the location and started banging on the front door causing the patrons inside to fear for their safety . Kevin stated that no one inside his establishment observed anyone with a gun .

Kevin went onto say that he is unable to give a description of the subjects and that they are not regular customers. Kevin advised me that he was the only manager on scene and that there was no security guard working. Kevin further advised me that there are three working cameras inside the tavren and one outside facing the northside parking lot, and that he in unable to access the camera system at this time.

P.O. Martinez Moore Squad 4342 observed a gray 4dr Chevrolet Malibu WI plate (805-TGR) leaving the location at which time he conducted a traffic stop and spoke with the driver Montey C. Edmon B/M 12-16-87 who stated that he just left the Silver Spring Tap and that his sister Dedra Conner Davis B/F 5-13-85 had a altercation with b/m at which time the subject started grabbing on his sister. Montey stated he attempted to stop the subject from grabbing his sister at which time the subject pushed him inside the tavern and they started to fight. Montey stated that the subject fled the location in a unknown direction. Montay was unable to provide P.O. Moore with any further information regarding the subject.

Future follow up will be conducted in attempt to view the camera system and obtain any additional information regarding this incident.

PA-33E Narrative

This Report of Incidents Involving Licensed Persons or Premises, original report, was submitted by P.O. Martinez MOORE PS# 015951 assigned to District 4, Late Shift.

On Saturday, September 19, 2015, at 2:14 A.M., Squad 4365, P.O. Ralph MCCLAIN and I, was dispatched to a Battery complaint at 3530 W Silver Spring Dr. (Silver Spring Tap).

Upon our arrival, I observed the victim, identified as Heather M GARCIA W/F, 05-27-83 address of 2757 N 76th St.; Milwaukee, WI 53222, unknown phone number, seated in the front passenger's seat of a black, 4dr, Chevrolet Cavalier, bearing WI plate of 155-UNR. GARCIA was bleeding profusely from injuries to her left eye and forehead she sustained from being battered. The vehicle, which was parked facing northbound on N 36th St, was being operated by GARCIA'S associate, identified as Micaela A SPREDEMAN W/F, 10-03-86 address of 2240 W Layton Av #321; Milwaukee, WI 53215, cell phone# 315-0126.

I immediately summoned medical attention to evaluate Heather GARCIA. Meda Care 204 arrived on scene and medically treated GARCIA in the back of their med unit. Soon thereafter, Meda Care 204 conveyed GARCIA to Froedtert Hospital for further medical treatment. Succeeding GARCIA'S conveyance, I interviewed Silver Spring Tap's security and bartender. The Security Officer was identified as Shawn J PERRON W/M, 02-11-78 address of 5659 N 39th St; Milwaukee, WI 53209, 414-722-4317.

Interview of Shawn J PERRON W/M, 02-11-78, Security

Shawn PERRON stated on Saturday, September 19, 2015, at approximately 2:00 A.M., he had a verbal altercation with a patron identified as Angela L SWOPE B/F, 11-26-82 address of 6943 W Herbert Av; Milwaukee, WI 53218, cell phone #535-1127. PERRON stated during the altercation, Heather GARCIA interjected herself into the argument. Shawn PERRON stated GARCIA attempted to escort SWOPE out the south entrance door. PERRON stated when GARCIA placed her hand on SWOPE'S back, SWOPE responded by pushing GARCIA upon her chest. Shawn PERRON stated a mutual fight ensued between GARCIA and SWOPE outside of the south entrance door. PERRON stated during their physical altercation, GARCIA was beaten badly by SWOPE. Shawn PERRON stated the fight continued from the south entrance door to the west entrance door. PERRON stated he opened the west entrance door in an attempt to pull GARCIA back in, however was unsuccessful due to the crowd that surrounded the fight. Shawn PERRON stated when the fight was finally over, he observed GARCIA laying on the ground, by the west entrance door, bleeding profusely from her face. PERRON stated Micaela SPREDEMAN called the police regarding. Shawn PERRON did not have any further pertinent information pertaining to this investigation.

Interview of Kevin S CULVER W/M, 10-07-67, Bartender

CULVER concurred with PERRON'S aforementioned statement. Kevin CULVER stated Heather GARCIA was a former Security Officer for Silver Spring Tap. CULVER stated he observed the verbal altercation inside the bar, however, did not observe the physical altercation outside the bar. Kevin CULVER stated he attempted to assist GARCIA inside the bar, by the west entrance door, however, GARCIA was unable or unwilling to come in. CULVER further stated the police was notified contemporaneous to the fight, and succeeding the fight. Kevin CULVER did not have any further information pertaining to this investigation.

Silver Spring Tap personnel were forthcoming with pertinent information pertaining to this investigation.

Heather GARGIA received 11 stitches at Froedtert Hospital for her injuries.

Angela SWOPE was subsequently arrested for Substantial Battery pursuant to the investigation. It shall be notified that SWOPE resisted arrest and had to be decentralized to be taken into custody.
