Description of work

Extend wire mesh fencing on north west corner of building 10 LF in a straight line with existing and 90 degree angle to building 5 LF. Fence will be at north end of building along N. 9th Street.

Add (1) 6" I-beam for post and attach angle iron to building to attach wire mesh.

Match I-beam and wire mesh (grid of 3"x3" squares) as close to existing as possible.

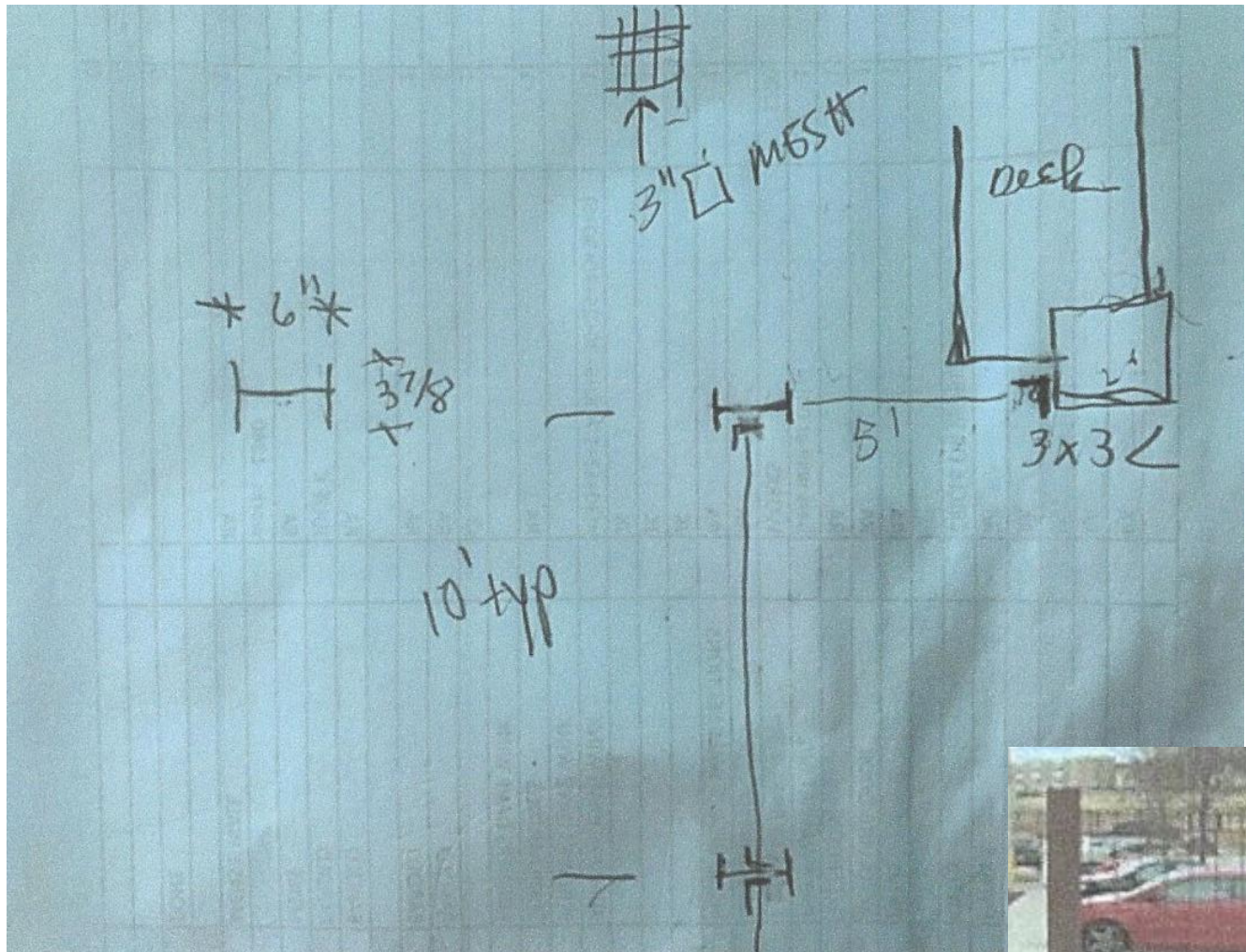
