Dear colleagues,

I write you on item 12 on PSH. When the Mayor's Office briefed me on this initiative deemed as "innovative" months ago-I immediately questioned the desire to seek more revenue by ticketing, fines and towing as a city. I requested an Equity analysis before any implementation because of possible disproportionate impacts.

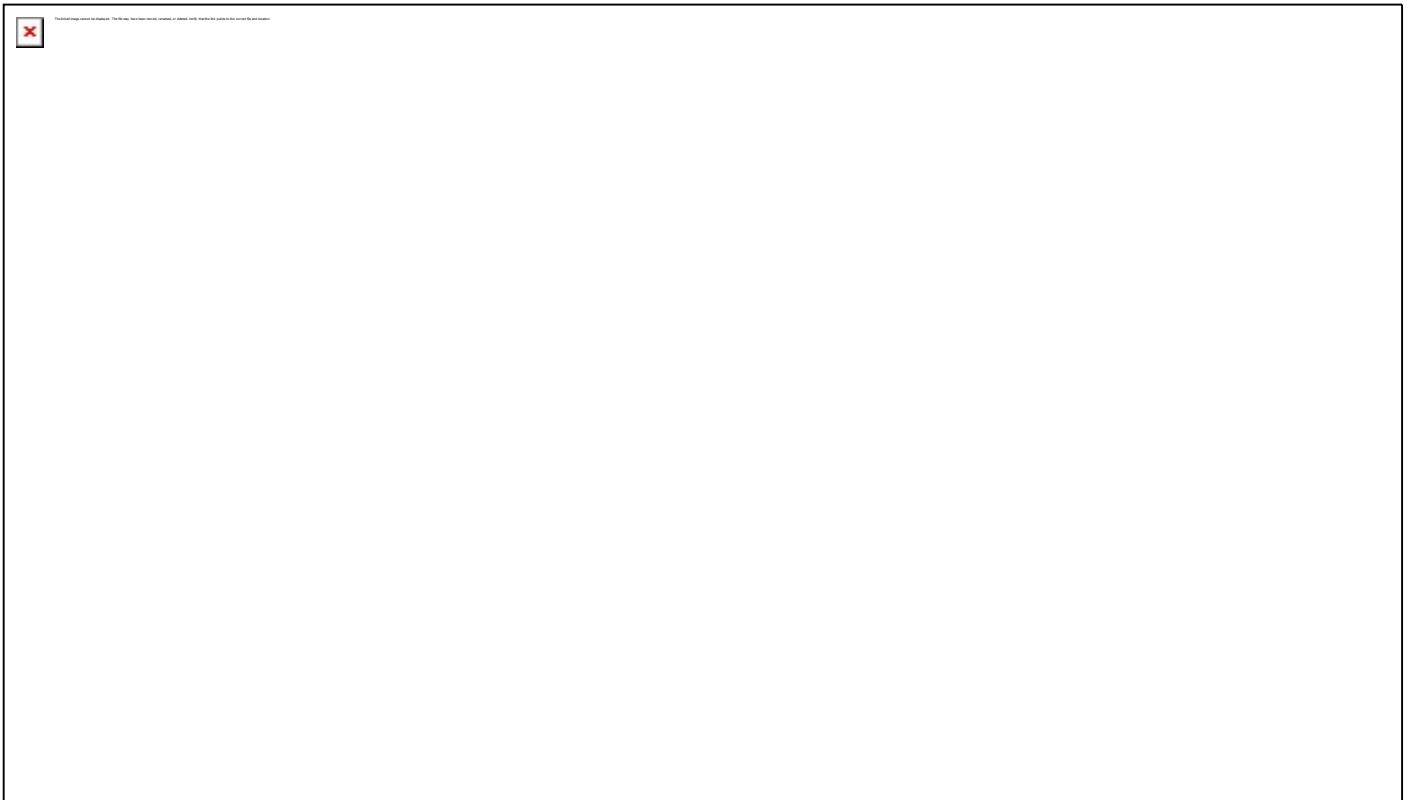
This analysis should be complete and reviewed prior to any action taken.

While we await this analysis I received this report from our outstanding LRB. As many of us have experienced, our municipal fines and parking enforcement have some imperfections.

Data from the City suggests that there is more ticketing in some districts than others, unequal parking options and many tickets are for not following street parking permit rules overnight.

Prior to making any more changes in a system that is flawed, let's pause and review this memo and await an equity impact study.

One city in the LRB study even ended towing as unjust.
