REASON FOR REQUEST:

Monique Foster, a City of Milwaukee police officer, was in the scope of her employment and operating a City of Milwaukee police vehicle that was traveling to the scene of a property damage motor vehicle accident on North Little Menomonie Parkway with its emergency lights activated. After the squad car stopped to wait for a tow truck to arrive, the uninsured motorist, who was travelling eastbound, lost control of their vehicle striking the driver's side door of the squad car, causing the accident. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to Wis. Stat. § 62.67 and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Foster sustained injuries to her head, neck, low back and ribs. The treating physician indicated the injuries to the neck and low back are permanent. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$44,023.13.
