LAST WILL AND TESTAMENT

I, TINY LEE BROCK, of the City and County of Milwaukee, State of Wisconsin, being of sound and disposing mind, memory and understanding, do hereby make, publish and declare this to be my Last Will and Testament, hereby revoking all other and former Wills and Codicils to Wills by me made, in the manner and form following, to wit:

FIRST: I hereby direct that my personal representative hereinafter named shall pay all of my just and lawfully collectible debts, funeral expenses, expenses of my last illness and the expenses of the administration of my estate as soon as conveniently can be after my decease.

SECOND: All the rest, residue and remainder of my estate both real and personal, of whatsoever name, nature, kind or description, of which I may be possessed and seized at the time of my decease I hereby devise and bequeath to my husband, JOSEPH BROCK.

THIRD: In the event that my husband, JOSEPH BROCK, shall predecease me, or in the event out deaths should occur simultaneously; or approximately so, or in the same common accident or calamity or under any circumstances causing doubt as to which of us survived the other, then I devise and bequeath all the rest residue and remainder of my estate to my daughter, JOSEPHINE BROCK, of Milwaukee, Wisconsin.

UNLAWFUL non-negligent injury to consumption of, or loss of any property used as provided herein.
