Dear Ms. Jenkins:

This office is in receipt of your claim in the amount of \$1,667.97, relating to damage sustained to your property on April 22, 2003 due to a clogged sewer and backwater at 4915 North 26th Street.

Our investigation reveals that the Infrastructure Services Division records indicate that this matter was investigated by them on April 22, 2003. The City sanitary sewer was clogged. The City main was cleaned and restored to proper working condition. The sewer was examined on May 9, 2003 with a closed circuit television and found to be in good condition. They have recorded one previous clogged sewer on this block; this happened on April 6, 1964. The sanitary sewer is on a normal three year cleaning schedule and was last cleaned on November 29, 2001. Because the sewer was on a regular cleaning schedule and the City did not have any notice of problems with the sewer, the City cannot be held liable. Accordingly, we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a letter within 21 days of the receipt of this letter to the Milwaukee City Clerk, 200 East Well Street, Room 205, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202, requesting a hearing.
