Dear Messrs. Dobert and Arena:

This is to notify you that on October 29, 2007, the City's Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the City's Common Council that your Class "B" Tavern license for the premises located at 2155 South Kinnickinnic Avenue ("Chaser's Pub") be suspended thirty (30) days. The Committee made such a recommendation based upon a police report and a complaint of Alderman Tony Zielinski seeking revocation of your license.

On November 2, 2007, you were sent a true and correct copy of the Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendations of the Licenses Committee with respect to this suspension. You were further notified that the Milwaukee Common Council would consider the matter at its meeting of November 21, 2007, commencing at 9:00 a.m., in the Common Council chambers, on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin. You were advised of your right to file written objections and to appear personally or by counsel to address the Common Council. At that date, time and place neither you nor counsel appeared and you did not file written objections to the report of the Licenses Committee.

Following consideration of the report of the Licenses Committee, the Common Council adopted a motion by a vote of thirteen (13) Ayes, one (1) Abstention and one (1) Excused to return this matter back to the Licenses Committee. You will be notified when this matter is scheduled before the Committee.
