4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

HARPER stated that he was currently in Florida on vacation and was unable to come in person. CIB-METRO was in contact with HARPER as well who was providing assistance from Florida regarding possible video surveillance recovery. HARPER stated that he had (2) bartenders working tonight identified as Sonya ROGERS (B/F 03/23/67) and Adrienne STORY (B/F 11/18/60). HARPER stated that he does not have security for the tavern.
