The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

1. On 12/29/2018 the applicant was charged in Milwaukee County with Carrying Concealed Weapon (Misdemeanor).

2. On 10/14/22 at 2:20p.m., Milwaukee Police conducted a License Premise Check at 3455 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr. This was in regards to a Shots Fired which took place outside of the store on 10/08/22 at 3:58p.m. Investigation revealed a patron had purchased a pizza for a youth inside the store, however, the cashier accused the youth of trying to steal the pizza, which caused a heated argument between patrons and the cashier. Another employee attempted to intervene and escort the crowd outside, however, was assaulted outside. The same employee returned inside the store and armed themselves with a firearm and went back outside, exchanging gunfire with a patron. Officers reviewed video surveillance and the armed employee was arrested. The employee was cooperative with the investigation.

- 3. On 10/14/22 at 7:37p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Subject Wanted at 3455 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr. On arrival officers identified the subject as an employee and were able to place the subject into custody with no further incident.
- 4. On 10/29/22 at 4:11p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Subject with Gun at 3455 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr. Investigation revealed a customer and employee were in a verbal argument, when the customer began making threats. The employee armed themselves with a rifle and demanded the customer exit the premise. The employee was cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident.
- 5. On 12/01/22 at 11:25a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Reckless Use of a Weapon at 3455 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr. Investigation revealed the employee observed what they perceived to be inappropriate behavior between a customer and possibly their son. When the employee advised the customer that type of behavior was not allowed, the customer pulled a gun, pointing it at the employee and making threats. The employee was cooperative with the investigation.
- 6. On 05/03/23 at 8:25p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Threat at 3455 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr. Investigation revealed a customer purchased a pizza, however, it was not cooked to their liking, therefore they requested a refund. The store has a posted no refund policy and offered to make a new pizza, however, the customer refused it and called the police to get their money back. The employees were cooperative with the investigation.
- 7. On 05/08/23 at 11:24a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery at 3455 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr. Officers were advised by the clerk two patrons were involved in an incident, however, had both left prior to police arrival.
- 8. On 07/04/23 at 11:39a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject at 3455 N. Martin Luther King Jr Dr. Investigation revealed the employee called the police after accusing a patron of stealing fireworks. Investigation revealed the employee actually placed the fireworks in the patron's bag by accident. The employee was cooperative and apologetic.
- 9. On 06/14/24 at 7:07p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Subject with Weapon at 3455 N. Martin Luther King Dr. Investigation revealed a customer was argumentative with the employee and when the customer was exiting the store, the employee fearing the customer was going to get a firearm, cocked their firearm behind the counter. The business was cooperative and allowed officers to view video surveillance.
- 10. On 07/13/24 at 1:19p.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Subject with Weapon at 3455 N. Martin Luther King Dr. Investigation revealed a customer was argumentative with the employee over the price of an item. The customer made a threat they would cut the employees throat. The employee pushed the customer back and grabbed their firearm pointing it at the floor. When the employee realized the customer did not have a weapon, they put their firearm away. The business was cooperative with the investigation and allowed officers to view video surveillance of the incident.
- 11. On 10/19/24 at 11:51a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Shooting at 3455 N. Martin Luther King Dr. Investigation revealed the suspect and employee were arguing, when the suspect produced a firearm and attempted to strike the employee with it, however, the gun went off, striking the employee in the chest. The suspect then fled the scene. MFD arrived on

scene and attempted life saving measures, however, were unsuccessful. An employee stated they heard the shot and observed their boss on the floor and called the police. The business was cooperative and provided video surveillance.

This report is written by P.O. Domenico RIZZO, assigned to district 5, late power shift.

On Friday, June 14th, 2024, at approximately 1907 hours, my partner P.O. Kimberly KANEKEO and I, squad 5438, were dispatched to 3455 N MLK Dr., Action Food and Liquor, for a Subject with Weapon complaint. The incident location is located within the city and county of Milwaukee. Both officers were equipped with Axon Body Worn Cameras, which were in operation at the time of the investigation.

Upon arrival, I observed the caller, who was identified as Kenthadius L. WILLIAMS (m/b 12-18-1993) arguing with the business manager, who was identified as Jamil I. OWIES (m/w 1-9-1998), at the counter. I separated both parties to obtain statements.

P.O. KANEKEO spoke to the WILLIAMS, who stated he arrived at the business to purchase some cigarettes. WILLIAMS stated OWIES told him "\$12.95". WILLIAMS stated he asked OWIES "\$12.95?", to which OWIES repeated to him "\$12.95". WILLIAMS stated he asked OWIES why he had to answer with an attitude. WILLIAMS stated OWIES told him get out of the store and heard the cocking sound of a "Shotgun".

I spoke to OWIES, who stated WILLIAMS entered the business and asked for cigarettes. OWIES stated he told WILLIAMS "\$12.95". OWIES stated WILLIAMS asked, "Why are you saying it like that". OWIES stated hen asked WILLIAMS "How you want me to say it, \$12.95?". OWIES stated WILLIAMS began using vulgar language and threatened "I'm going to fuck you up, I got my gun and I'm going to get it." OWIES stated WILLIAMS exited the business, to which he thought WILLIAMS was going to get a gun. OWIES did state he cocked his draco firearm behind the counter due to fearing WILLIAMS obtaining a firearm. OWIES stated he never presented the firearm. OWIES stated WILLIAMS kept arguing with him, to which he asked WILLIAMS to leave the business multiple times.

I spoke to WILLIAMS's wife, who was verbally identified as Chakaris M. WILLIAMS (f/b 8-15-1989). C. WILLIAMS stated went into the business at approximately 1915 hours and observed N. WILLIAMS and OWIES arguing. C. WILLIAMS stated N. WILLIAMS told her OWIES "pulled out a shotgun".

I reviewed surveillance footage, which depicted WILLIAMS entering the business. Footage depicted WILLIAMS standing at the counter and arguing with OWIES. Footage depicted WILLIAMS exiting the business. Footage depicted OWIES cocking the firearm behind the counter as WILLIAMS was exiting the business as he went back to his vehicle. Footage depicted WILLIAMS continue to argue with OWIES.

OWIES was cooperative throughout the investigation.

This report was written by P.O. Terry BELL assigned to District Five Squad 5140.

On Saturday, July 13th, 2024, at 1:19 pm, I was dispatched to N 7th Street and W Keefe Ave for a Subject With Weapon incident.

Upon our arrival, I observed a male who identified as the caller arguing in the business with an employee of the business. Other customers were in the business attempting to purchase items.

I spoke to the caller, Dementhis D CARTER (M/B, 07-08-78) who called stating a male subject pulled a gun on him. CARTER stated that the employee of the business pulled a gun on him during an argument. CARTER stated that the employee also choked him.

P.O. PETTY spoke with the accused employee, Jamal I OWAIS (A/M, 01-09-98) and business owner, Mohammad I OWAIS (A/M, 09-11-84) who both stated that CARTER entered the store and upon attempting to purchase a bag of chips, disputed the price of the items. OWAIS stated that CARTER tossed the chips at the counter and attempted to hand OWAIS \$1. The chips were listed at .75 cent a bag. OWAIS informed CARTER that his \$1 wasn't enough to cover the price of the chips. OWAIS then stated that CARTER went to look at the price then became enraged, stating "Y'all are trying to rob mel The price is .50 cent a bag!" CARTER approached the counter yelling about the price. OWAIS stated that he attempted to snatch the chips from the counter when CARTER yelled "I'll cut your throat!". OWAIS stated that he then attempted to push CARTER back as he grabbed for his firearm. OWAIS stated that he then racked his firearm, leaving the firearm pointed at the floor, and ordered CARTER to leave the store. OWAIS stated that CARTER refused to leave and instead called 9-1-1. OWAIS stated that once he observed that CARTER possessed a phone in his pocket and not a firearm, he placed the firearm back in his pocket.

I spoke with CARTER who stated that he and OWAIS argued over the price of the chips. CARTER stated that within the argument, he threatened to have OWAIS exit the business, and come outside to fight due to personal statements OWAIS made against the family of CARTER. CARTER stated that he tossed his money at the counter, OWAIS tossed it back at him, then proceeded to grab him by his throat. CARTER stated that OWAIS then warned him that if he didn't leave the store, he would shoot him.

P.O. PETTY reviewed the surveillance recording as I interviewed CARTER. P.O. PETTY stated that the account made by OWAIS was accurate with what was depicted in the surveillance recording.

Jr. Dr., Action Food and Liquor, which is a licensed premise in the city of Milwaukee.

Upon arrival, I assisted with retrieving video of this incident. The video that was retrieved showed a customer inside of the store at the checkout counter involved in an argument with the store clerk, Jamil OWIAS, the brother of the business agent. As they continue to argue the customer pulls out a firearm from his pants pocket and attempts to strike the clerk with the gun, but shoots the store clerk, shooting the clerk in the chest. The customer then runs out of the store and leaves in a vehicle. Shortly after you see another employee walking from the back of the store to the front of the store on his phone.

The clerk was located lying on the floor behind the cash register, in the employee area. The Milwaukee Fire Department attempted life saving measures, but the life saving measures were unsuccessful.

As officers and detectives were investigating this incident, the agent of the business, Mohammad OWIAS arrived with friends and family, but due to being angry and visibly shaken about the death of the Jamil, OWIAS's family and friends tried to keep him calm. I was not able to speak to him about the business licenses or about the clerk who was working. I did not look for any licenses, in order to see if they were posted or valid due to how the investigation was proceeding such as location of the body and the limited space in the store with multiple officers and detectives to move around.

Due to the amount of people that were showing up outside of the store, along with talk among those who were there, that people may try rush past officers as the medical examiner was removing the body, it was best to just have the body removed once the investigation was completed and allow OWIAS to enter his store.

I did check LIRA and found that OWIAS does have a valid Class A license, which is set to expire 11/02/2024.

There was also another employee, Martin STENNIS, a cook at the store who was working at the time of the incident. In reading the CAD the caller calls at 11:52 a.m. and tells dispatch he heard shots fired and came out to find his boss shot, non responsive and that the subject is no longer at the store. The employee did stay and did speak to detectives.

This is still an active investigation by CIB, so if any further information is needed, please contact CIB.

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 12/3/2024 at 1:40 PM in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. This is a public hearing. Those wishing to view the proceeding are able to do so via the City Channel – Channel 25 on Spectrum Cable – or on the Internet at http://city.milwaukee.gov/citychannel. Those wishing to provide oral testimony via internet are asked to contact the staff assistant, Yadira Melendez at (414) 286-2775 or stasst5@milwaukee.gov for necessary information. Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

- 1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
- 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
