

The above application has been made by the above named applicant(s). This requires approval from the Licenses Committee and the Common Council of the City of Milwaukee. The hearing before the Licenses Committee will take place on 1/28/2020 at 10:45 AM, in Room 301-B, Third Floor, City Hall. If you wish, you may provide testimony at the hearing regarding the request; see below for further information. You are not required to attend the hearing. - 2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
- 3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
- 4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

Franks did not say anything to us on scene. MFD assisted Frank to Cheryl's vehicle, because Frank was having trouble walking on his own.

Once at Frank's residence we assisted him into the house. Frank wanted to go back to the bar to get his vehicle. Frank did not make any sense when he was talking. Frank kept stating he wanted to get his car and he was in the marines for 34 years and retired over 20 years and he had an issue and started drinking. I asked Frank how many drinks he had and he just stared at me and could not answer.

While at the house Frank could not walk on his own and needed assistance. Frank had an odor of alcohol coming off of his body. When asked how much he had to drink, Frank just kept saying I had some beers and I was in the Marines.

Cheryl told us this has been an issue for awhile. Cheryl stated Frank is having signs of dementia. Cheryl also stated once Frank found out he has cancer and his mom died he started to drink a lot. Cheryl stated she has tried talking to the owner of the bar to get him to stop serving Frank because he gets so drunk and things like this happen, but Cheryl stated he walked away stating if he doesn't drink here he will drink somewhere else.

Squad 6240 went back to Coach's Bar and spoke to the owner and bartender.

Owner - Corne M HANSSEN (W/M 05/20/54)

HANSSEN stated he arrived at the bar today and saw Frank for a few minutes before he was leaving.

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
