REASON FOR REQUEST:

Moises Gomez, a City of Milwaukee police officer, was in the scope of his employment and a passenger in an unmarked police vehicle that was responding to a shooting at 1108 West Greenfield Avenue. The police vehicle was traveling northbound on South 11th Street and was stopped in the intersection of South 11th Street and West Greenfield Avenue waiting to make a left turn to travel west on Greenfield when the uninsured motorist, without warning, failed to stop and rearended the City vehicle. A few seconds later, a second uninsured motorist rearended the first uninsured vehicle, pushing it back into the squad car. As a result of the conduct of the uninsured motorists, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to § 62.67, Stats, and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Gomez sustained injuries to his neck, back and jaw. The medical expenses and lost wages totaled \$4,472.54.
