There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

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<b>Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:</b>	Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.
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Failure to attend this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants and partnership applicants must attend or attend by an attorney. The agent or attorney for corporate or limited liability applicants must attend. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing.

You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition attend the virtual hearing and are willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should request an interpreter attend the meeting with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

**ADDITIONAL COMMENTS/RECOMMENDATIONS:**

This report is being submitted by Officer Carlos Felix assigned to District One, Early Shift.

On Wednesday March 31, 202 at 11:330AM I met with Nicholas Marking the agent for the business, which will be located near the river in the lower half of the parking lot at 1301 N. Edison Street. The Lot is managed by Interstate Parking. Plans are to have steel barricade dividing the southwest corner of the lot restricting approximately 40 parking spots, and have a

ten foot access point for patrons to enter the area. The far south corner will house two food trucks and a 20 foot container bar that will also act as barriers. On the east side of the lot there is a concrete wall to enclose the area and the west side abuts the river. They will use wrist bands to identify patrons 21 and over, and only beer will be served at this location. Two portable restrooms will be provided along with a hand washing station. The estimated capacity is around 400 people. There will be 30 table to dine at and no tents are in the plans. The business will close during inclement weather. Contracting with a private security company will be addressed if the agent feels that it is needed. I advised of cameras which the agent plans on installing two and rope lighting along with the two existing pole lights.

This was the end of the CPTED and reprot.

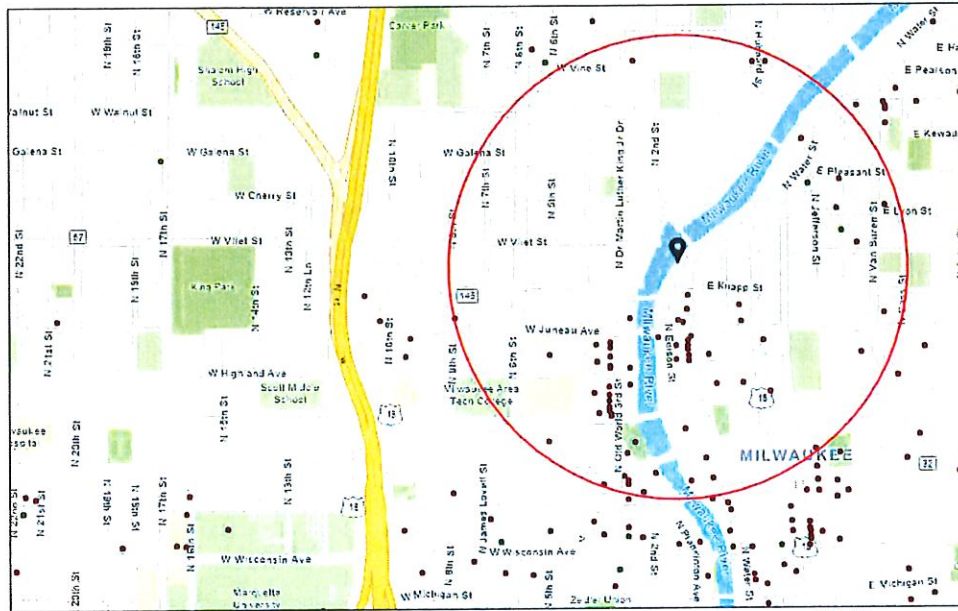


# City of Milwaukee Concentration Map
