Dear Office of the City Clerk Claims:

On July 27th 2019, approximately 5pm Martha Watts {claimant] was walking across sidewalk on 48th st off Burleigh and stepped down unto dirt area which use to have grass and now is all tree roots and about to enter street to cross back over to 3107 no 48th occumpancy and fell and injured right elbow. It was an extrteme hard fall and cracked my elbow which caused me severe pain after one week when elbow didn't get better so martha went to the emergency outpatient for xray and doctor. Martha was sent to an orthopedic doctor to review break. After her visit with Dr, Beck the orthopedic doctor he said there was nothing he could do for the break and had to do physical therapy and exercise. This is a permanent damage to her elbow and could have been avoided if the city of Milwaukee would maintain there property better.

Martha's fall was due to the large roots that grabbed her foot and plunged to her fall.

Martha is asking for all expenses of doctors and xray to be paid back to her plus restitution for pain and suffering and loss of work.

Martha is a hair dresser and her use of her right arm is vital she is right handed, this has slowed her down at the time of accident and in future.

Documents of expenses are enclosed and pictures of area where fall took place can be sent of viewed by email or text.

I am also requesting this area be repaired so this incident doesn't happen to my customers or anyone else.

As the building owner Jollc on 3107 n. 48^{th} Milw, Wisc 53216 Martha has requested repairs to curbs street and grounds but city does patch up work and never really fixes anything. Martha pays her taxes on a timely manor and appreciates all the help she can get to maintain support to Sherman park.

In regards to need for making a demand for compensation due to injury on city property goes as follows:

My demands are:

Future possible medical bills for doctor and possible physical therapy......\$1000.00

Because I have pain where bone is cracked in elbow when bending arm

Loss of Income for loss of work not being able to servicing clients on hair services

Which I have to use my right arm which became limited due to pain and loss of movement

My demand is 2 weeks pay totally.....\$2500.00

My demand for pain and suffering is 3 times my out of pocket cost, loss of work and future medical bills (pain and suffering because my arm will not ever be the same due to this fall which resulted in a life long break that nothing can be done about just maybe therapy to keep it mobile).

\$762.02+\$1000.00+\$2500=\$4262.02

\$4262.02x 3= \$12786.06
