

(4) The Marine Corps Reserve.


(5) The Air National Guard of the United States.

(7) The Coast Guard Reserve.



The Guard's Unique Dual Missions



Federal Mission: “maintain properly trained and equipped units available for prompt mobilization for war, national emergency or as otherwise needed”



State Mission: “provide trained and disciplined forces for domestic emergencies or as otherwise required by state laws”




THE ARMY MODULAR FORCE: How We Will Change to Brigade-Centric Organizations

FROM: An Army based around large, powerful, fixed organizations

TO: An Army designed around smaller, more self-contained organizations



... and modular multi-functional Support Brigades



- É Don't have to deploy a whole division to get certain capabilities
- É Employ smaller, tailored forces instead of one or two large units
- É Creates a larger pool of units to rotate into operations
