Dear Council Members:

Returned herewith is a document filed by Attorney Laurie Eggert for attorney's fees for representing Police Officer Eric Fjeld. The claim is in the amount of \$4,889.50 including \$60.50 in disbursements for 43.90 hours of service billed at the rate of \$110.00 per hour. We ask that this matter be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation.

We have reviewed this claim and advise that in our opinion, the time spent was reasonable. Legal representation was occasioned by a criminal investigation. No criminal charges were brought against the police officer on whose behalf this claim was filed.

As we have advised you under similar circumstances in the past, the Common Council has discretion to reject this claim or to pay it in whole or in part. Wis. Stat. § 895.35, *Bablitch and Bablitch v. Lincoln County*, 82 Wis. 2d 574 (1978).

The above-named police officer has retained us to represent him in connection with the above-referenced matter.

Consistent with its policy, the City Attorney's Office has refused to represent him, and as he was performing the duties of his office at the time of the events giving rise to the incident, the claim is hereby made on his behalf for the indicated legal fees. This incident involved a suicide while in custody.

The MPD conducted a criminal investigation and investigated the suicide as a critical incident. IAD compelled PO Fjeld to give a statement after issuing a PI-21. The DA conducted an inquest and declined to issue any charges after the jury ruled it a suicide. Attached is a copy of the DA's letter and an itemization of the time and services rendered.

### Dear Chief Jones:

In the early morning hours of January 19, 2003, Michael D. Gardipee, d.o.b. 08-27-1961, attempted suicide by hanging himself in a cell at the 2<sup>nd</sup> District police station of the Milwaukee Police Department. The booker-lockup officer, P.O. Eric J. Fjeld, undertook intervention and paramedics were summoned. Mr. Gardipee was conveyed to St. Luke's Medical Center and died there on January 21, 2003 from complications incident to the attempted suicide. A Milwaukee County inquest jury on May 23, 2003 found probable cause to believe that Mr. Gardipee's death was a suicide. Judge Dennis Moroney with my agreement determined that there were no grounds to instruct the jury on a criminal offense by any officer, and no such instruction was given. I am satisfied that no officer committed an offense.

I was advised by Marty Drapkin, Jail Officer Training Coordinator for the Department of Justice, Training and Standards Bureau, that no statute or regulation requires your department to provide special training to officers who serve as booker-lockup officers in municipal lockups. This contrasts with the many hours of training required of deputies who will serve as jailers. The responsibilities are different, but in the area of suicide prevention, there is some overlap.

It appears that the Milwaukee Police Department provides only on-duty training for the booker-lockup responsibilities. A new officer assigned the booker-lockup operation receives one or more shifts of one-on-one training from an officer who has already performed as a booker-lockup officer. When asked what he had been trained to do when he saw Mr. Gardipee, apparently in the process of hanging himself, Officer Fjeld answered that he had not been trained in that particular regard. With various officers providing the one-on-one training, I suspect that there are wide variations in the quality of training for this responsibility. My belief is that a consistent, higher quality of training would be provided were the responsibility for such training to be placed in the Police Academy. I do not know how many hours of academy training would be needed to ideally prepare an officer for performing the booker, and particularly, the lockup function.
