Dear Council Members:

Returned herewith is a document filed by Attorney Laurie Eggert for attorney's fees for representing Police Officer Steven Hainzl. The claim is in the amount of \$711.50 including \$7.50 in disbursements for 6.40 hours of service billed at the rate of \$110.00 per hour. We ask that this matter be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation.

We have reviewed this claim and advise that in our opinion, the time spent was reasonable. Legal representation was occasioned by a criminal investigation. No criminal charges were brought against the Police Officer on whose behalf this claim was filed.

As we have advised you under similar circumstances in the past, the Common Council has discretion to reject this claim or to pay it in whole or in part. Sec. 895.35, Stats., *Bablitch and Bablitch v. Lincoln County*, 82 Wis. 2d 574 (1978).


Dear Mr. Leonhardt:


*did call a supervisor (Sgt. STOJKOVIC) and reported the issues between he and SWEENEY, at which time Sgt. STOJKOVIC advised that she would receive the citation.*

*Investigation into this matter did reveal that complainant Lisa SWEENEY a.k.a. Lisa GREGG was the subject a Milwaukee Police Department Vice Control Division investigation. Miss SWEENEY is the former owner of the Bare Bottom Maids cleaning service investigated by the Vice Control Division for prostitution. It should be noted that Officer HAINZL'S girlfriend Anna NAVARRETTE was a former employee for said service.*

**CONCLUSION:**

*Investigation as it relates to this incident could not substantiate complainant SWEENEY'S assertion that Officer HAINZL was using his police powers for retaliatory purposes. Officer HAINZL explained the parking citations received were the result of a citizen complaint and upon further inquiry the vehicle on both occasions was found to be parked in violation of the night parking ordinance. Also, prior to issuing Miss SWEENEY a citation for speeding Officer HAINZL did summon a supervisor and apprised him of his concerns between himself complainant SWEENEY. Officer HAINZL reports that he was then directed by said supervisor to issue the speeding citation. Also, this investigation did reveal that Officer HAINZL did submit the appropriate copy of the citation for processing. It is for the above cited reasons that this incident will be cleared as baseless.*
