REASON FOR REQUEST:

City of Milwaukee Police Officer, Thomas Johnson, was in the scope of his employment and operating a City of Milwaukee Police vehicle that was traveling westbound on Burleigh in the City of Milwaukee. As the claimant's vehicle stopped to make a left turn into an alley at about North 30th Street, the uninsured motorist, who was also traveling westbound on Burleigh, rear-ended the City vehicle, causing the accident. As a result of conduct of the uninsured motorist, there is liability on the City of Milwaukee pursuant to §62.67 Stats., and the City of Milwaukee's Uninsured Motorist Self-Insurance Plan.

Officer Johnson sustained contusions and an injury to his right knee. On June 7, 1999, a right knee surgery was performed and the treating surgeon has assigned a 3% permanent partial disability. The claimed medical expenses and lost wages total \$12,424.33.
