NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING
TO RESIDENTS OF THE
CITY OF MILWAUKEE, WISCONSIN

Notice is hereby given that the staff of the Department of City Development, on behalf of the City of Milwaukee, Wisconsin (the "City"), will hold a public hearing at 9:00 a.m. on September 14, 2001 in the Second Floor - West Conference Room at 809 North Broadway regarding the proposed issuance by the City of industrial development revenue bonds pursuant to Section 66.1103, Wisconsin Statutes, as amended, in a maximum aggregate face amount of \$6,000,000 on behalf of Air Wisconsin Airlines Corporation, doing business as United Express (the "Borrower"). The bonds would finance the costs of the construction of an approximately 55,000 square foot aircraft maintenance hangar and office and storage facility immediately east of Howell Avenue at General Mitchell International Airport. The facility will to be owned by the County of Milwaukee and operated by the Borrower.

The public hearing will be conducted in a manner that provides a reasonable opportunity to be heard for persons with differing views on both issuance of the bonds and the location and nature of the proposed facility. Any person desiring to be heard on this matter is requested to attend the public hearing or send a representative. Written comments (not exceeding 250 words) may be presented at the hearing if submitted in advance to the Clerk of the Issuer.

Comments made at the hearing are for the consideration of the Issuer and the Mayor of the City of Milwaukee, but do not bind any legal action to be taken by them.
