- 1. At all times hereinafter mentioned, plaintiff was and still is a resident of 1649 North 35th Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53208
- 2. Defendant, City of Milwaukee, Police Department, is a U.S. Government agency.
- 3. The jurisdiction of this court is invoked pursuant to Title 18, U.S.C. Section 242, 'Deprivation of Rights Under Color of Law'.
- 4. Statement of Fact: I Deandre Johnson was in the basement of my resident feeding my pet when I heard an explosion followed by the breaking of glass. Before I could ascend the stairs to investigate I was hostilely greated by dangerous weapons being held by officers of the Milwaukee Police Department. After being escorted upstairs to my main living area I noticed that the explosive device that was discharged through my window from the outside did in fact cause a fire to my window curtain as well as my furniture. Witnessing by sight and sound the destruction of my personal property as well as structural damage to my home I sat detained and handcuffed on my couch. After hours of searching both common areas and structural I was informed that I was under arrest, under protest and under duress, I was taken from my home and imprisoned for a period of not less than (2) days. Upon my release I was informed that no charges would be filed meaning that I had committed no crime.

5. WHEREFORE, plaintiff demands:

Money damages in the amount of \$150.000 One Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars. Permanent injunction against the defendant from performing certain acts in the future. (harassment, unlawful acts, or any acts served as revenge for this lawsuit). Any further relief which this court may deem appropriate.
