



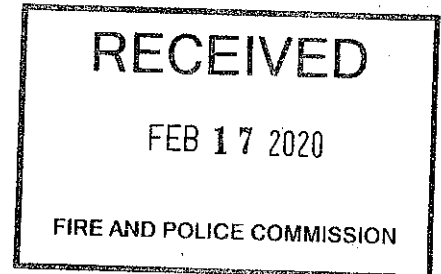

MALVICK during the following period: April 25, 2020 through May 8, 2020.
