**1. Description of Grant Project/Program (Include Target Locations and Populations):**

Identify and target major drug trafficking and criminal organizations in support of DEA 360 Strategy and Special Operations Divisions (SOD) project Rolling Thunder. This multi-agency strategy uses co-located Strike Forces to target Heroin Drug Trafficking Organizations (DTOs) and interrupt the trafficking of narcotics. Nationwide coordination is required for investigators to dismantle criminal enterprises through the creation of comprehensive databases and information sharing. The OCDETF is also the driving force behind the efforts to target Transitional Organized Crime (TOC), which often times involves large networks of international drug trafficking and criminal activity.

**2. Relationship to City-wide Strategic Goals and Departmental Objectives:**

The overtime funds will solely be used to assist this federal agency in current and future joint law enforcement operations.
