

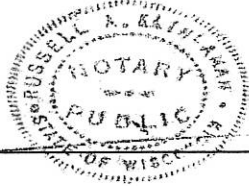

181642 A substitute ordinance relating to the city's towing drop fee.
