There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or mortion he following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-2.7-4, probative evidence concerning whether or not a new license should be granted may be presented on the following subjects: whether or not the applicant meets the municipal requirements, the appropriateness of the location and premises where the licensed premises is to be located and whether use of the premises for the purposes or activities permitted by the license would tend to facilitate a public or private nuisance or create undesirable neighborhood problems such as disorderly patrons, unreasonably loud noise, litter, and excessive traffic and parking congestion. Probative evidence relating to these matters may be taken from the plan of operation submitted with the license application, if any, but shall not include the content of any music. Evidence regarding the fitness of the location of the premises to be maintained as the principal place of business, including but not limited to whether there is an overconcentration of businesses of the type for which the license is sought; whether the proposal is consistent with any pertinent neighborhood business or development plans, or the location's proximity to areas where children are typically present. The applicant's record in operating similarly licensed premises; and whether or not the applicant has been charged with or convicted of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the activity to be permitted by the license being applied for or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety or welfare may also be considered. See attached police report or correspondence.

Notice for applicants with warrants or unpaid fines:

Proof of warrant satisfaction or payment of fines must be submitted at the hearing on the above date and time. Failure to comply with this requirement may result in a delay of the granting/denial of your application.

Failure to appear at this meeting may result in the denial of your license. Individual applicants must appear only in person or by an attorney. Corporate or Limited Liability applicants must appear only by the agent designated on the application or by an attorney. Partnership applicants must appear by a partner listed on the application or by an attorney. If you wish to do so and at your own expense, you may be accompanied by an attorney of your choosing to represent you at this hearing. You will be given an opportunity to speak on behalf of the application and to respond and challenge any charges or reasons given for the denial. No petitions can be accepted by the committee, unless the people who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify. You may present witnesses under oath and you may also confront and cross-examine opposing witnesses under oath. If you have difficulty with the English language, you should bring an interpreter with you, at your expense, so that you can answer questions and participate in your hearing.

You may examine the application file at this office during regular business hours prior to the hearing date. Inquiries regarding this matter may be directed to the person whose signature appears below.

RE: Notice of After Set Activity at 802 N 35th Street

Dear Sadaqat Ali:

This letter is notice to you that the Milwaukee Chief of Police, by the chief's designee, the district commander, has determined that a person associated with the premises located at 802 N 35th Street ("the premises") has engaged in after set activity pursuant to Milwaukee Code of Ordinances 80-11, After Sets.

The Milwaukee Police Department has responded to the following described after set activity at the premises:

- 1. On Friday August 26th, 2022 at 1:49am, officers were dispatched to 802 N 35th Street for a Subject with Gun complaint. The caller stated they observed multiple subjects with guns go into an abandon building for a possible party. Officers responded and spoke with the renter of the location who stated he started renting about a month ago and this was his first event hosted inside the location. The renter initially stated to officers he had proper licensing for the event but later redacted the statement. Officers conducted a check of the location and observed 10 individuals inside the location. Officer spoke with one female individual who stated she was there for a party. Officer heard loud music from inside their squad vehicle approximately 50 feet away. Officers observed colorful strobe lights inside location, hookah, stripper poles, food (buns, condiments, warming dishes), plywood bar with plastic cups, dance floor with mirrors and television on the wall, lounge area (with couch), an empty bottle of Hennessey. Officers noted there were no licenses for the location. Officers filed a report regarding this incident. This is a violation of s.108-5 of the code.
- 2. On Saturday September 3rd, 2022 at 7:01am, officers were dispatched to 802 N 35th Street for a Shooting complaint. Caller stated victim is shot in the leg. Caller stated they heard about 12 shots. Officers arrived on scene and located a victim shot. Upon arrival officers spoke with renter of location who stated the victim departed his after-set party with no problems. The renter stated approximately 30 seconds after the group left the party he heard 10 gunshots, looked outside of the location and observed the victim on the sidewalk bleeding. While officers were inside the location they observed a large gold.

"stripper pole" in the middle of the room, a makeshift bar made out of 2x4 pieces of wood, and numerous plastic cups filled with a dark substance. Detectives spoke to a witness who stated she and a group of people were leaving the bar after close and went to the location for an after-set. The witness stated as they were leaving the after-set someone fired shots and ultimately struck the victim. The witness stated she recognized the suspect from the after-set party. Detectives described the inside of the location to be a night club. The renter stated to detectives he is in the process of updating the building with the intent to open a night club/bar. Officers and detectives filed reports regarding this incident. This is a violation of s.108-5 of the code.

The City of Milwaukee has determined that the unlicensed sale or distribution of alcohol beverages and the operation of public entertainment by individuals or entities that have not applied for or received, or are not eligible for, the appropriate licenses or permits as required by code, particularly when these activities take place on premises not zoned for commercial activities, constitute a public nuisance.

This letter is notice to you that the cost of future enforcement of any subsequent after set activity engaged in by a person associated with the premises, as defined by s. 80-11 of the code, at least fourteen days after the issuance of this notice may be assessed and collected as a special charge against the premises.

If you are billed for the costs of enforcement relating to 3 or more separate occurrences of after set activities within one year, you may be issued a citation of not less than \$1,000 nor more than \$5,000 after notification by the chief of police that the premises is a chronic after set premises due to your failure to abate the after set activities.

On Wednesday April 19, 2023 I was assigned to Squad 3274, and conducted a business check of Rock N. Roll Variety Shop located at 802 N. 35th St.

Squad 3271, Police Officer Taylor CARLONI assisted me in a business check.

The business had a bright neon "Open" sign that was lit and activated in the front window of the business.

I spoke to the manager of the business identified as Obryan Maurice MUNGON (B/M 12-18-01) who stated that the business has been open for several weeks. MUNGON stated the business is opened from 10am-8pm all days of the week. MUNGON stated the owners of the business were identied as Bobby Jo WATKINS and PAKEETA L. SKEETS(B/F 03-25-68).

I observed shoes on the walls and clothes on the tables in the middle of the room. There was snacks, hookah pipes, tobacco products including but not limited to Black and Mild's, nicotine vape devices, cigarettes.

P.O. CARLONI checked the City of Milwaukee Website that revealed that there was no business license(S) listed to the address of the business 802 N. 35th St.





- 5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)

- 6. You may then provide testimony.
- a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
- b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
- c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
- d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
- 7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
- 8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
