Dear City of Milw,

I am writing this letter ~~CITY CLERK'S OFFICE~~ to make a claim for money I over paid you on my residence.

I overpaid the city 10 quarters of solid waste fees on my residence at 1863 N. Pulaski St.

I own and have lived at the address for almost 40 years. I also own 9 other properties on N. Pulaski St including a tavern.

I get 10 water bills for all my properties and I just found this error in May or Apr.

The city has been charging me for a two family instead of a single. I went back and discovered that I overpaid 506.88. On finding this out I called sanitation and they said they would investigate.

About 3 weeks later the city sent me an adjusted bill for 1 quarter overpayment (48.60). After the letter I called a woman named Nicole about this matter and she said the city has an ordinance that states if I don't catch the city error within 20 days I lose my overpayment money. I was shocked. I asked Nicole if my home was a single family home. She said yes. I asked Nicole if I overpaid for 10 quarters. She said yes.

After this phone call with Nicole I called my Alderman Nick Kevae to explain my situation. He said he would look in to it for me and get back to me.

Nic called me back a few days later and seemed to agree that the city owe me my overpayment back. He said the best recourse would be to make this claim.

I feel that I should not have to correct the city's mistake within 20 day. I shouldn't be penalized for their error.

I think this ordinance could be fixed to remedy this situation.

I am ~~not~~ asking for money which I feel is <sup>the</sup> thing. I would just like my overpayment returned.


Nicole has look at all the bills and agreed this is correct. Her phone # is
