
Dear Sir(s):

Dear Sir:

I was told that I could expect a response concerning my claim 6 - 8 weeks following the time that the paper work left your office. It is now 3 months since the incident took place and approximately 10 weeks since the claim was sent to the next person. Because I have not been apprised of the disposition of the claim, I am wondering if I did not make as clear as I should have just what took place.

My car is parked in what is called the Hickory parking lot that is behind the building address 1336 East Randolph Court. I have an arrangement with my neighbor who lives in one of the Hickory buildings to park in her assigned parking space. She does not own a car, and that parking lot is actually in back of my building. It is more convenient for me to enter the back of my building (1342) from the Hickory parking lot. I point this out because my address does not match the building address of the lot where I regularly park. If anyone came back for another look at the site, he may have been confused about the address and that the sketch I submitted with my letter (claim) did not look right.

A supervisor did come out one week following the incident (October 12, 2005). By that time a neighbor had used his junk car to push the dumpster back in place. I had told him twice not to do so, but he did it anyway. When the supervisor came out on October 19, 2005 I explained to him what had happened, and I thought he accepted my explanation as to why the dumpster was in the place it should be and not in the place where it had caused a problem. The garbage truck driver was with him and kept shaking his head to indicate that he had done no such thing. I believed, though, that the supervisor accepted my explanation and made an assessment of my honesty. He gave me a sheet of instructions as to how I should make a claim.


My neighbor in the Ash parking lot told me that their dumpster had been placed out from its usual spot on that very day, too. Their parking arrangements were not affected, though.

I did take pictures of my car and of the dumpster placement at that time. I sent in the claim with just a sketch, not having had the film processed. I am enclosing pictures now. The replacement of the mirror happened the day after the incident; Keith at Shorewood Auto Repair (E. Capitol Drive) told me that I should do so, otherwise the mirror, hanging from its moorings, would cause some damage to my car. The supervisor who saw my car on October 19, 2005 saw that the mirror had already been replaced.

Besides the pictures I am again enclosing copies of the receipt from Shorewood Auto Repair, and an estimate from Pinkey's Capital Auto Body for the damage to the rear right side.

I think this is a just claim, and I would appreciate a prompt response. Thank you.

I am enclosing: -a receipt for the replacement of the mirror (Shorewood Auto Repair, 1330 E Capitol Drive) \$126.47




