

You are here by notified that the Milwaukee Common Council will hold a hearing on February 27, 2001, commencing at 9:30 a.m., or as soon thereafter as this matter may be heard, in the Common Council chambers on the third floor of City Hall, 200 East Wells Street, Milwaukee, Wisconsin to consider your renewal of you Class "B" Bartender License.

Attached you will find a copy of the Report of the Utilities and Licenses Committee which includes their Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and Recommendation, recommending non-renewal of the Class "D" Bartender License. The recommendation is the result of nonappearance.

## FINDINGS OF FACT

- 1. Joyce H. Flechner (hereinafter the "Licensee") is the holder of a Class "D" Bartender License in the City and County of Milwaukee, Wisconsin. Said license expired at midnight, December 31, 2000.
- 2. An untimely application to renew said license was filed with the Office of the City Clerk on January 11, 2001.
- 3. Pursuant to Chapter 90 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances and Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes, the matter was referred to the Milwaukee Police Department for investigation. On January 12, 2001, the Milwaukee Police Department responded with a police report that created a basis for renewal of said license.
- 4. On February 2, 2001, the City Clerk's Office provided timely notice to the Licensee pursuant to Chapter 90 of the Milwaukee Code of Ordinances and Chapter 125 of the Wisconsin Statutes of the report of the Milwaukee Police Department and included therewith a copy of the Milwaukee Police Department report. The matter was scheduled for a hearing on the Police Department report on February 12, 2001, commencing at 9:00 a.m. in Room 301B of City Hall. At said date, time and place, the Licensee failed to appear at the hearing.
- 5. Based upon the sworn testimony heard and the evidence received at the hearing, the Committee finds the following:
  - A. Notice of hearing was sent to Joyce H. Flechner at 315 East Clarence Street, Bay View, Milwaukee, WI 53207 on February 2, 2001 by the Office of the City Clerk. It was sent in an envelope with the return address of the License Division. It was sent by United States prepaid mail. The address to which the notice was sent was the address used by the applicant on her application. The envelope containing the notice was not returned to the License Division. The Licensee failed to appear at the hearing on February 12, 2001.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

## CONCLUSIONS OF LAW

- 1. The Committee has jurisdiction to hold hearings and provide Findings of Fact, Conclusions of Law and a Recommendation to the full Common Council pursuant to Chapter of the <u>Wisconsin Statutes</u> and Chapter 90 of the <u>Milwaukee Code of Ordinances</u>.
- 2. Based upon the above facts found, the Committee recommends that the Class "D" Bartender license of Joyce H. Flechner not be renewed.

## RECOMMENDATION

Based upon the Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law stated above, the Committee, by a vote of five (5) ayes to zero (0) noes, recommends that the Class "D" Bartender License o Joyce H. Flechner not be renewed based on non-appearance and untimely filing of application for renewal.
