Dear Ms. Vera-Queveda:


We have received your claim for the amount of \$2,002.51 in relation to the damage you sustained to your 1999 Chevrolet Venture on February 28, 2013.

The Support Services-Fleet Division completed the investigation of your claim, and has found that the damages you are claiming do not appear to be caused by a City of Milwaukee snow plow. Measurements of both vehicles were taken, and the height of the damage to your vehicle does not align with the height of the snow plow. Although police were called to the accident scene, there are no other witnesses to confirm a City of Milwaukee vehicle was involved. It does not appear the City of Milwaukee was negligent; therefore we are denying your claim.

If you wish to appeal this decision, you may do so by sending a letter within 21 days of the receipt of this letter to the Milwaukee City Clerk, 200 East Wells Street, Room 205, Milwaukee, Wisconsin 53202, requesting a hearing.
