There is a possibility that your application may be denied for one or more of the following reasons: The recommendation of the committee regarding the application shall be based on evidence presented at the hearing. Per MCO 85-4-4, unless otherwise specified in the code, probative evidence concerning non-renewal, suspension or revocation may include evidence of the following: failure of the applicant to meet municipal qualifications, pending charges against or the conviction of any felony, misdemeanor, municipal offense or other offense, the circumstances of which substantially relate to the circumstances of the particular licensed or permitted activity, by the applicant or by any employee or other agent of the applicant. If the activities of the applicant involve a licensed premises, whether the premises tends to facilitate a public or private nuisance or has been the source of congregations of persons which have resulted in any of the following: disturbance of the peace; illegal drug activity; public drunkenness; drinking in public; harassment of passers-by; gambling; prostitution; sale of stolen goods; public urination; theft; assaults; battery; acts of vandalism including graffiti, excessive littering, loitering, illegal parking, loud noise at times when the licensed premise is open for business; traffic violations; curfew violations; lewd conduct; display of materials harmful to minors, pursuant to s. 106-9.6; or any other factor which reasonably relates to the public health, safety and welfare, or failure to comply with the approved plan of operation. The licensee should be prepared to address these matters at the hearing.

The Milwaukee Police Department's investigation regarding this application revealed the following:

The following items pertain to 2213 N Martin Luther King Jr

1. On 09/17/25 at 8:00p.m., Milwaukee Police were investigating a shooting that occurred across the street from the business. The business assisted with the investigation by allowing officers to view video surveillance.
2. On 10/12/25 at 12:26a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Trouble with Subject. The business called regarding an intoxicated subject causing a disturbance, refusing to leave. The subject was no longer on scene upon officer's arrival.
3. On 03/28/26 at 1:06a.m., Milwaukee Police were dispatched to a Battery. On arrival, officers observed security attempting to escort patrons out. An argument ensued between patrons and a security officer, at which time the officer observed a security officer swinging at a patron, however, did not make contact. The security officer was uncooperative with the officer, refusing to provide their information, as was the manager of the security company the officer is employed with. The business stated they were hosting a special event and the security company is not their usual security. The business was cooperative with the investigation and stated they would attempt to gather video surveillance relevant to the incident and provide it to MPD,

Upon arrival, we spoke to the owner who verbally identified himself as Paul D Burgess (b/m, 3-10-80). We informed Burgess about that incident that had occurred across the street from his establishment and asked to view his cameras.

Burgess was able to retrieve video depicting the incident and emailed it to P.O. Labensky.

We advised Burgess since his establishment was new, we would gather some basic information and conduct a license premise report.

This report is written by Police Officer Alfred TWYMAN, assigned to *DISTRICT Five, Late Shift SQUAD NUMBER 5341*.

On Sunday, *October 19th, 2025, at approximately 00:26AM*, I was dispatched to a Trouble with subject complaint at 2213 N Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Ave. (Summer of "85") located in the city and County of Milwaukee.

Upon *my arrival* I observed a security guard standing out front at the doorway of the location I spoke to the caller/employee, *Keionte T BOND (B/M 11/17/1997) (414)742-4747*, Who stated that he observed a B/F who was intoxicated trying to work some of *the men at his establishment*. And when security went to approach her to let her know she has to leave the establishment she got real irritate and aggressive towards his staff and threw one of her shoes at them and missed which resulted in another patron at the establishment to get hit by her shoe. Once this female was outside the establishment, she continued to be aggressive towards his staff and arguing with them.

I spoke with security to try and get the information of the women; however, they were not able to obtain it.

I observed several individuals inside of "Summer of 85", along with security staff and the bartenders. When speaking with one of the employees, BOND, stated that around 11:30 am he noticed this B/F who was intoxicated going around bothering some of the men trying to get them to give her money and drinks. BOND stated that he had never seen this woman in his establishment and didn't know who she was. That's when he had his security staff let the woman know she has to leave this location and she got upset and started cause a scene for him and his staff. BOND stated he does have video surveillance of the incident and showed it to officer, and Officer sent him a link to upload the video. I observed the license premises were up to date at this location, and they had operational exterior and interior camera. BOND and the business were very cooperative with this investigation.

This report is written by PO Ray PEARSON, assigned to DISTRICT 5 Late Power Shift, Squad 5467, with my partner PO Kievante LOVE.

On Saturday, March 28th, 2026, at approximately 1:06 am, we responded to "Summer of 85", 2213 N Martin Luther King Dr, located in the City of County of Milwaukee for a battery complaint.

While on scene, we observed a large crowd of patrons exiting Summer of 85. Security can be observed telling patrons to leave the location and not stand in front of the establishment. While on scene, I could

hear a male patron yelling saying, *"I don't give a fuck"*. PO LOVE and I approached the bar and attempted to assist security remove patrons from the establishment.

While security was escorting patrons out of the bar, PO LOVE and I observed bar security attempting to force a patron out of the bar by grabbing them by their clothing and escorting them out of the premises. PO LOVE and I attempted to intervene to prevent a further altercation. PO LOVE and I separated an unidentified black male from a security guard, known as "Shawn." PO LOVE and I attempted to calm down the parties by separating them and speaking with them. "Shawn" then approached the unidentified male telling him to, *"stop playing"*, before he swung at the patron with an open hand. PO LOVE and I intervened again, separating the parties once more. I could hear the unidentified male saying, *"he just swung at me"* to PO LOVE. The unidentified male did not claim injury or remain on scene to be a victim of a crime. Contact was not made with "Shawn" swinging at the patron, thus why he was not arrested.

I attempted to speak with "Shawn" about the incident in which he was highly uncooperative. "Shawn" refused to identify himself stating, he did not make contact with the patron, thus there was no reason to identify himself. It should be noted that "Shawn's" demeanor was extremely aggressive during the entire incident. "Shawn" was observed yelling at several patrons in an aggressive manor during the entirety of our time at this location.

I was advised by the bar owner, Paul D. BURGESS (B/M 3-10-80) that "Shawn" is not a regular security guard at his establishment. BURGESS stated that "Shawn" works for Midwest Elite Protection Agency and is related to a family member. BURGESS stated he does not know "Shawn's" full name. BURGESS informed me that "Shawn's" manager was on scene, advising me that she may be able to help identify "Shawn". BURGESS stated he was hosting an event with a celebrity and explained to me why he didn't clear everyone from the bar when the incident 1st began. BURGESS stated he allowed the "chill patrons" to go downstairs while his security removed the problem makers.

I also spoke with Justin HUBBARD (B/M 2-13-78) who was the manager on duty for Summer of 85. HUBBARD stated he did not know the name of the security company hired for the hosted event. HUBBARD stated I would have to speak with the security company's manager, whom he knew as "Mia".

I spoke with Melissa FREYTES (W/F 8-6-92) who stated she was a supervisor for Midwest Elite Protection Agency. I asked FREYTES who was the identity of her employee in which she became uncooperative. FREYTES stated, *"Respectfully, he does not want to give his information. There's a reason for that. He gave your sergeant...something already going on with him. So, you guys already have his information."* FREYTES stated she did not observe the incident outside of the location and only arrived after additional squads arrived on scene. FREYTES stated she was informed that people were only shoving and pushing each other. No punches or kicks landed. FREYTES provided a business card with the following contact information.

I then spoke with BURGESS again in order to recover video. BURGESS appeared to be intoxicated and was struggling to recover the footage from his cell phone, stating that he does not currently have a dedicated security system. BURGESS stated he would need some time to go over the footage to see exactly what occurred during the incident inside and outside of the bar. BURGESS stated he remembers people shoving each other, which prompted hookahs falling off tables. BURGESS stated he did not observe any people fighting, only pushing. BURGESS was provided a PV-17 and a link to evidence to upload video of the aforementioned incidents.

Summer of 85 staff (BURGES and HUBBARD) was cooperative with our investigation. Video of the incident is currently pending. Follow-up will be conducted if no video is recovered.

Midwest Elite Protection Agency (FREYTES and "Shawn") was NOT cooperative with our investigation. Despite being advised that "Shawn" had swung on a bar patron, FREYTES refused to cooperate by knowingly refusing to disclose information.

Summer of 85 licenses were checked, and they were operating within their license limits during the time of the incident. No infractions were observed. No arrests were made. No citations were issued. No injuries reported.

Please make such requests no later than one business day prior to the start of the meeting. You are not required to attend the hearing, but please see the information below if you would like to provide testimony. Once the Licenses Committee makes its recommendation, this recommendation is forwarded to the full Common Council for approval at its next regularly scheduled hearing.

Important details for those wishing to provide information for the Licenses Committee to consider when making its recommendation:

1. The license application is scheduled to be heard at the above time. Due to other hearings running longer than scheduled, you may have to wait some time to provide your testimony.
2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
 - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
 - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
 - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
 - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.
Please Note: If you have submitted an objection to the above application your objection cannot be considered by the committee unless you personally testify at the hearing.

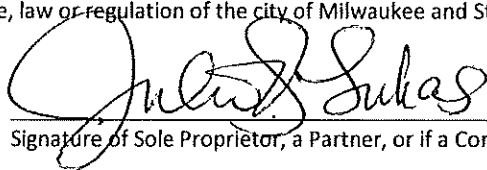
