2. You must appear in person and testify as to matters that you have personally experienced or seen. (You cannot provide testimony for your neighbor, parent or anyone else; this is considered hearsay and cannot be considered by the committee.)
3. No letters or petitions can be accepted by the committee (unless the person who wrote the letter or the persons who signed the petition are present at the committee hearing and willing to testify).
4. Persons opposed to the license application are given the opportunity to testify first; supporters may testify after the opponents have finished.
5. When you are called to testify, you will be sworn in and asked to give your name, and address. (If your first and/or last names are uncommon please spell them.)
6. You may then provide testimony.
  - a. Include only information relating to the above license application.
  - b. Include only information you have personally witnessed or seen.
  - c. Provide concise and relevant information detailing how this business has affected or may affect the peaceful enjoyment of your neighborhood.
  - d. If by the time you have the opportunity to testify, the information you wish to share has already been provided to the committee, you may state that you agree with the previous testimony. Redundant or repetitive testimony will not assist the committee in making its recommendation.
7. After giving your testimony, the members of the Licenses Committee and the licensee may ask questions regarding the testimony you have given or other factors relating to the license application.
8. Business Competition is not a valid basis for denial or non-renewal of a license.

This report is written by PO David LETTEER, assigned to District 5, Late Power Shift, Tavern Squad 5468.

On 11-27-18 at 8:54 p.m., I conducted a tavern check at Murray's Bar, located at 2474 W. Hopkins St., which is a licensed premise in the city of Milwaukee.

Upon arrival, I was met by the wife of the owner, Mary A. MURRAY (b/f 12-25-62) who was able to allow me to view the Class B Tavern License (0206092). The license was valid and expires 05-20-19. While speaking with MURRAY, I asked her if the bar would be open on New Years Eve. MURRAY stated she believed that the bar would be closed on New Years Eve and the reason for this was last New Years Eve, someone was shooting outside of the bar and a bullet entered the bar through a window. She did not want to have any patrons hurt due to someone else outside the bar shooting.

As I continued to speak to MURRAY she did tell me that if they were open on New Years Eve, the bar would have an armed security person at the door, to check people. She stated the crowd at the bar would be 35 and older and the security person would be the nephew of her husband and agent of the bar, Mark A. MURRAY (b/m 04-15-67).

I informed her that if they are open on New Years Eve, that the police would come into the bar and make sure there were no problems at the bar. MURRAY welcomed the police coming into the bar and checking on them.

Upon arrival, the bar owner, Mark Murray, said that one of his female bar patrons had her car keys stolen from her coat pocket sometime between 11:30 pm on February 13 and 12:45 am on February 14.

Murray suspected a male patron that was sitting on the victims coat had found the car keys and left the bar and likely drove off with the victims silver 2010 Buick Lacrosse 4DR vehicle equipped with On-star.

Murray provided a description of the male patron and Officers contacted On-star requesting a GPS location of the vehicle. A location was provided and subsequently, the vehicle was located, stopped, and a suspect was arrested.

The suspect was identified as Troy T Vaughn, BM, 11-21-1972, who fit Murray's description of the male patron he suspected of taking the keys.

Criminal charges will be reviewed on Friday, February 15, 2019 at 8:30 am with the Milwaukee County District Attorney's Office.




I know you have a lot to do but maybe someone from your office could ask them to do a better job cleaning up after themselves?


