Purpose of Contract/Amendment:

It is recommended that Milwaukee Fire Department (MFD) be allowed to dispense with the City's competitive bid process and enter into Single Source Service Contract for Fire Boat Refurbishment with Metalcraft Marine US, Inc. (Metalcraft) for the completion of performance as contained herein.

The contract total is \$948,200.00 in accordance with the Specification for Milwaukee Fire Department Fire Boat Refurbishment and purchase order.

Background:

MFD originally contracted with Metalcraft circa 2006 to build this boat. In recent years, necessary maintenance has been deferred due to budget constraints, leading to a loss of seaworthiness. There have been temporary, stop-gap measures taken to get the boat in a condition to be used recently, and those repairs cannot sustain the craft any longer. Metalcraft, being the original shipwrights, is the only authorized contractor to perform these refurbishments.
