Dear Ms. Pitts:

We are in receipt of your claim for damages that occurred on an unspecified date in May of 2022, for \$4,420.45, when a recycling crew allegedly caused damage to the siding of your garage from a recycle cart located at 4645 N. 68th Street.

Our investigation revealed that the Sanitation Services Section reported that your garage is within close proximity to the alley line car service location, and that the damaged location to the garage were measured from the ground to be 42" high and extends up to 48" of height. Photos were taken as part of this investigation that revealed the recycling cart height measuring at 42", which is below the full extent of your damages, making the strike point of the cart to be highly unlikely the cause. The Sanitation Section checked maintenance records, checked with crewmembers, and found no record of incidents that occurred at 4645 N. 38th Street.

There is no evidence that the City is liable for damages. Residents are requested to move the cars to the alley line for collection and return carts to the storage location after collection. As such, we are denying your claim.
