**Proposal** The two front porch posts are deteriorated and failing. The applicant is proposing

replacing the columns with custom made columns with Ionic capitals and square

bases to match existing.

Staff comments The proposed columns will be constructed of cedar with proportions to match the

> existing columns. The lonic capitals are also proposed to be constructed in cedar in the Greek Erechtheum-style to match the existing capitals. Staff has no concerns

with the proposed replacement columns.

Recommendation Approve

**Conditions** All finish wood must be smooth and free of knots and must be painted or treated

> with an opaque stain upon completion. Note: when new, bare wood is left exposed to the exterior elements for a period of only a week or two, the life the of the paint job subsequently applied to it will be decreased. The use of a decay-resistant wood for is required for porch areas. Using western white pine or Ponderosa pine is "at your own risk" because this wood has no natural decay resistance and can

deteriorate in some exterior settings in just a few years.
