Returned herewith is a document filed by Attorney Laurie Eggert for attorney's fees for representing Police Officers Marcell Daniels and Gena Melanche. The claim is in the amount of \$924.43, including \$11.43 in disbursements for 8.30 hours of service billed at the rate of \$110.00 per hour. We ask that this matter be introduced and referred to the Committee on Judiciary & Legislation.

We have reviewed this claim and advise that in our opinion, the time spent was reasonable. Legal representation was occasioned by a criminal investigation. No criminal charges were brought against the Police Officers on whose behalf this claim was filed.

As we have advised you under similar circumstances in the past, the Common Council has discretion to reject this claim or to pay it in whole or in part. Sec. 895.35, Stats., *Bablitch and Bablitch v. Lincoln County*, 82 Wis. 2d 574 (1978).

Captain BECK states he observed Mr. REDMOND the whole time he was there until the time he was placed in the squad car and did not observe any officer clothesline Mr. REDMOND during this incident.

Both Officers Marcell DANIELS and Gina MALANCHE made statement regarding this incident. These officers both state that Mr. REDMOND was uncooperative and refused to place his daughter off of his shoulders. These officers also state Mr. REDMOND was verbally abusive and Officer DANIELS had to call for a backup to help take Mr. REDMOND into custody. Both Officers DANIELS and MALANCHE denied that either one of them clotheslined Mr. REDMOND or sprayed his daughter with O.C. spray.

### **CONCLUSION:**

On Friday, September 21, 2000, this case was reviewed at the Milwaukee County District Attorney's office by Deputy District Attorney Jon REDDIN for a charge of Battery allegedly against Police Officer Marcell DANIELS. Deputy DA REDDIN declined to issue charges against Officer DANIELS due to the statements of security officers and independent witnesses who all state that Officer DANIELS acted properly when taking Mr. REDMOND into custody. For said reasons this incident will be cleared as warrant refused.
