5. DESCRIPTION OF PROJECT:

We will maintain the current porch framing and footprint but raise the sinking front rim joists and isntall new footings to restore the integrety of the framing. New stairs need to be made We will use 2x12 pressure treated pine for the stringers as per building codes. The stair treads will be made with 2x6 clear douglas fir with wester red cedar for the risers and trim. All douglas fir and cedar will be primed on all sides with oil based primer and painted with two coats of latex paint in a color to match the home's color scheme. The new stairs will be 60" wide as are the current stairs with framing in place to move the railings inside the stair framing when the time comes to replace the hand rails. The new stairs will be built the same as the attached porch. The photo is a recent job G. Williams Woodcraft completed.
