Dear Mr. Assad:

This is to notify you that on Tuesday, October 15, 2002, the Utilities and Licenses Committee voted to recommend to the Common Council that your application for a Class "A" Liquor and Malt license for the premises at 2700 N. Murray Ave. be denied. The Committee made such recommendation based upon a concentration of alcohol beverage outlets in the vicinity of the location for which you are seeking a license, the belief that the health, safety and welfare of the neighborhood would be impaired by the granting of this license for this location, and neighborhood objections related to noise, litter and traffic concerns.

On that same day, the Common Council considered the Committee's recommendation regarding your application, adopted the Committee's recommendation and denied your application.

You are eligible for a refund of your license fees by bringing in your receipt or filing an affidavit for refund within one year to date of action with the License Division, Room, 105, City Hall.
